Claypool and Arthur Sevey, and their agents, attorneys, employees and all persons acting by, through or under them or either of them, and each and all of them, be, and they are hereby forever enjoined from in any manner interfering with the continuous, free and exclusive use and enjoyment of one hundred (100) inches, miner's measurement, of the waters of Cottonwood Creek, in and upon said premises, as provided in said decree, and the decree and order of the Board of Control is hereby modified so as to make the same conform in all respects to the decree aforesaid.
