BEFORE THE STATE WATER BOARD OF THE STATE OF OREGON JOSEPHINE COUNTY.

IN THE MATTER OF THE DETERMINATION OF THE RELATIVE RIGHTS OF THE VARIOUS CLAIMANTS TO THE USE OF THE WATERS OF SUCKER CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF THE ILLINOIS RIVER.

SUPPLEMENTAL FINDINGS

Now on this 19th day of November, 1919, the above entitled matter coming on before the State Water Board of the State of Oregon for consideration as to the completion of the inchoate rights of the various claimants to the use of the waters of the above named stream and its tributaries as determined by the Findings of the State Water Board (then Board of Control) of the State of Oregon entered January 22, 1912, and the decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County, entered on the 31st day of May, 1913, and it appearing to the Board that the time for completion of each and all of such inchoate rights as set forth in said decree and Findings has expired. That a survey has been made by a representative of the State Engineer which accurately shows the area and location of the additional lands that have been irrigated by virtue of such rights, and that after notice to each of the claimants, duly given by registered mail, a hearing was held at Holland, Oregon, on April 3, 1919 by Mr. Rhea Luper, a duly authorized representative of the State Water Superintendent, at which time such claimants appeared and sibmitted their proofs of completion of such inchoate rights, all of which is now a part of the record herein, and the Board being fully advised in the premises, makes the following

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER OF DETERMINATION.

1.

That Beagle Bros have succeeded to the interest of Frank O. Meeker and L. A. Burnett to that part of their lands situated in the $\mathbb{E}^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of the $\mathbb{N}\mathbb{E}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ of Section 33, T 39 S. R. 7 W., and the water right certificate for said lands shall be issued to said Beagle Brothers.

That Guy Fetterly of Kerby, Oregon, has succeeded to the interest of J. B. Barkett, and the name of Guy Fetterly will be substituted hereafter in this proceeding and in the water right certificate in place of the name of

said J. B. Barnett.

That Mary Ellen Leonard is deceased, and that R. S. Leonard is the administrator of her estate, and the water right certificate will be issued to the Estate of Mary Ellen Leonard.

That G. J. Lind has succeeded to the interest of J. R. White.

That H. B. Reed of Kerby, Oregon, has succeeded to the interest of Samuel Miller and Hattie Miller.

That D. G. Twidwell has succeeded to the interest of Frank O. Meeker and L. A. Burnett to that part of their lands situated in the $\mathbb{W}^1_{\mathbb{Z}}$ of the $\mathbb{N}^1_{\mathbb{Z}}$ of Section 33, T. 39 S. R. 7 W.

That Alex White is deceased and that his estate has been duly administered and the interest is now vested in the heirs at law of said Alex White, deceased.

That E. D. Stephenson has succeeded to the interest of E. H. Wise.

That the names of the successors in interest as hereinbefore set forth shall be substituted hereinafter in this proceeding for the persons succeeded, and the water right certificates will be issued to such successors in interest.

2.

It further appears that in an order filed and entered May 31, 1913, Volume 9, Circuit Court Journal for Josephine County, pages 555 and 556, the order of determination in the above entitled matter, in so far as it affects the rights of Ora Smith, was set aside and the matter was referred to the State Water Board for further proceedings and the said Ora Smith was granted the privilege of filing an amended proof of claim for consideration by said Board.

In accordance with said order, said Ora Smith filed his amended claim on July 2, 1910 and it is hereby found, ordered, adjudged and decreed that the water rights of said Ora Smith shall have the date of priority of the year 1858 for the use of not to exceed one second foot of water from Sucker Creek, through the White ditch for the irrigation of the following described lands: 7.55 acres $SW_4^1NE_4^1$; 2.99 acres $SE_4^1NE_4^1$; 1.12 acres $SE_4^1NW_4^1$; 6.40 acres $NE_4^1SW_4^1$; 8.64 acres $NE_4^1SE_4^1$ and 22.48 acres $NW_4^1SE_4^1$ of Section 25, T. 39 S. R. 8 W., and that said Ora Smith is entitled to a certificate of water right in accordance therewith.

It further appearing that A. J. Fulk filed an affidavit with the State Water Board on April 3, 1919, wherein it is shown that the description of his lands, as set forth in the order of determination in the above entitled proceeding, is not correct, due to an error in the adjudication survey, which was not discovered until the resurvey of the inchoate lands had been made by the State Engineer. That an examination of said lands has been made by a representative of the State Water Board and the facts stated in said affidavit found to be true, it is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed that the water right of said A. J. Fulk is appurtenant to the following described lands:
4 acres $SW_{\pm}^{1}NE_{\pm}^{1}$; 37 acres $NW_{\pm}^{1}SE_{\pm}^{1}$; 5 acres $SW_{\pm}^{1}NW_{\pm}^{1}$; 26 acres $SE_{\pm}^{1}NW_{\pm}^{1}$ and 30 acres $NE_{\pm}^{1}SW_{\pm}^{1}$ of Section 35, T. 39 S. R. 8 W.) and that he is entitled to a water right certificate in accordance therewith.
