### -: FINDINGS AND ORDER OF DETERMINATION:-

Now on this 13th day of April, 1910, this matter coming on to be considered by the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, upon the evidence and proofs herein, and the said Board of Control having considered the same and being now fully advised in the premises, finds:

(1)

That a proper petition, praying for an adjudication of the relative rights to the waters of Willow Creek, in Gilliam and Morrow Counties, Oregon, and tributary to the Columbia River, signed by John Peterson, J.F. Deos, C.L. White, and S.S. Ewing, water users on the said stream, was filed heretofore and on the 7th day of April, 1909, with the Beard of Control of the State of Oregon.

(2)

That upon an investigation the said Board of Control found the facts and conditions such as to justify the making of a determination of the relative rights of the various claimants to the waters of said stream, and thereupon, by an order duly made and entered on the 15th day of April, 1909, fixed the 14th day of July, 1909, as the time when the State Engineer of the State of Oregon would begin the investigation of the flow of said stream and of the ditches diverting water therefron, and the 28th day of July, 1909, at the hour of 10 o'clock A.M., as the time when, and the Circuit Court room, in the County Courthouse, in the town of Heppner, in Morrow County,, Oregon, as the place where, the Superintendent of Water Division No. 2 would begin the taking of testimony and proofs of the various claimants to the waters of said stream.

(3)

That pursuant to such order a notice, setting forth the date when the State Engineer of the State of Oregon would begin the investigation of the flow of said stream, and of the ditches diverting water therefrom, to-wit: the 14th day of July, 1909; and the place and time certain when the superintendent of the water division in which said stream is situated should begin the taking of testimony and proofs as to the rights of the parties claiming water therefrom, to-wit: the 28th day of July, 1909, at the hour of 10 o'clock A.M., at the circuit court room, in the county courthouse, in the town of Heppmer, in Morrow County, Oregon, was duly and regularly published in two issues of the Arlington Record, a newspaper having a general circulation within the County of Gilliam, Oregon, and printed and published at Arlington, within said County of Gilliam; and also, was duly and regularly published in the Heppmer Gazette, a newspaper printed and published at Heppmer, in Morrow County, Oregon, and having a general circulation within said County of Morrow, Oregon; said stream being situate within said Counties of Morrow and Gilliam; due proof of such publication in each of said newspapers being now on file in the office of the Board of Control and a part of the record herein; that said Superintendent of

Water Division No. 2 did, on the 12th day of June, 1909, send, by registered mail, a similar notice to each person, firm, and corporation claiming the right to the use of any of the waters of said stream, or its tributaries, and to each person, firm and corporation owning or being in possession of lands bordering on or having access to said stream or its tributaries, in so far as such claimants could be reasonably ascertained, and that said superintendent did enclose with said notice a blank form on which said claimant, owner, or person in possession should present in writing all of the particulars necessary for the determination of his rights to the waters of said stream to which he lays claim; due proof whereof being now on file in the office of said Board of Control and a part of the record in this cause.

(4)

That pursuant to such notice a duly qualified assistant of the State Engineer did proceed to make an examination of said stream and of the works diverting water therefrom, including the measurement of the discharge of said stream and of the carrying capacity of the various ditches and canals diverting water therefrom, and an examination and approximate measurement of the lands irrigated and susceptible of irrigation from said ditches and canals, which said measurements and observations have been reduced to writing and made a matter of record in the office of the State Engineer of the State of Oregon; and that said Superintendent of Water Division No2 did, at the time and place in said notice specified, take the testimony and proofs of claimants to the waters of said stream, said claimants being hereinafter named in the finlings as to their respective rights, due proof of such hearing being now on file herein, and a part of the record in this cause.

(5)

That upon the completion of the taking of testimony and proofs afores id by the said Superintendent of Water Division No. 2, he did, on the 20th day of September, 1909, give notice by registered mail to each of the claimants to the waters of said stream (hereinafter named in the findings as to their respective rights) that all of the evidence, testimony and proofs of the various claimants would ve open to inspection for a period of ten days (Sundays excepted), beginning on October 12th, 1909, and ending on October 22p 1909, from 9:00 o'clock a.m. until 12:00 o'clock a.m., and from 1:00 p.m., until 5:00 o'clock p.m. of each day, and that the determination of the Board of Control would be heard by the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Morrow County; due proof of the mailing of said notices by registered mail being now on file in this cause.

(6)

That pursuant to said notice the said division superintendent did, at the time and place in said notice specified, hold such inspection, due proof whereof being now on file herein.

(7)

That no contests or other objections have been filed with said division superintendent and that the time for filing the same has long since expired.

(8)

That all evidence, testimony and proofs filed with the said Superintendent in the above entitled matter have been transmitted by him in person to the said Board of Control and are now on file in said office of said Board.

That the following named persons and corporations were duly notified as declared in Finding No. 3 herein, but that each and all of them have failed, neglected and refused to file any claim to the waters of said stream or any tributary thereof, and are in default herein, and have no interest in, or claim to, the waters of said stream, or any tributary thereof; said persons, firms, and corporations so being in default herein, with their postoffice addresses, being as follows, to-wit:

That Willow Creek is a natural watercourse, rising in said Morrow County, Oregon, and flowing thence in a general northerly direction through lands situate in Morrow and Gilliam Counties, Oregon, to the Columbia River, of which it is a tributary within said Gilliam County; and said stream is entirely situate within said Morrow and Gilliam Counties. Oregon.

(11)

That the soil of the irrigable lands lying along said stream is chiefly volcanic ash and is chiefly cultivated to crops of alfalfa and for gardens.

(12)

That each of the appropriations of water for the purpose of irrigation hereinafter set forth, is limited to an amount of water sufficient for the irrigation and reclamation of the lands described herein as being the lands to which such water is appurtenant, and the total volume of water so appropriated and hereby confirmed in each case shall not exceed the rate of one cubic foot per second of time for each sixty (60) acres of land irrigated.

(13)

That a system of rotation in the use of the water, among the several appropriators of water in the same neighborhood, has been in use, more or less, upon the said stream and its tributaries, and adds greatly to the duty which said water may be made to perform; and that in the absence of an agreement between such appropriators arranging for such rotation, and the manner in which such water shall be used in such rotation, the water master of the district in which such water is situated shall arrange such appropriators in groups or systems of toation, first giving to the appropriator who is first in priority an amount of water equal to the combined appropriations of all the appropriators in said group or system for a length of time bearing the same ratio to the whole time required to make the complete rotation through the whole group of appropriators as the appropriation of said first appropriator bears to the combined appropriations of said appropriators, and shall serve the next appropriator in priority with a like amount of water for his proportionate time and so on, untill all the appropriators in said group are served; then the distribution of the water shall be repeated in the same manner throughout the irrigating season; that in case any two or more of appropriators in said group shall have the same priorities, then the said water master shall distribute the water as between those appropriators having the same priorities to the one whose ditch taps the stream nearest its source first, and the next lower down next and so on, and where two or more appropriators agree as between themselves as to a manner and system of rotation in the use of their water, the said water master shall distribute their water in accordance with such agreement: Provided, and this whole Finding No. 13 is upon the condition, that such arrangement into groups and systems shall not interfere with the prior rights of any appropriator not a member of such group or system.

(14)

That Rhea Creek and Thorn Creek, a tributary of said Rhea Creek; Hinton Creek; Balm Fork of Willow Creek; Eight Mile Creek; Skinner Creek; and Mc-Kinney Creek, are natural watercourses, situate within said Morrow and Gilliam Counties, Oregon, and tributary to or branches of said Willow Creek, and all appropriators of water from said tributaries or branches of said Willow Creek are hereinafter named in regard to their respective rights in the tabulated statement hereinafter set forth in Finding No. 15 hereof, under the particular tributary or branch of said Willow Creek from which their respective appropriations are made.
