IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR THE COUNTY OF UNION.

IN THE MATTER OF THE DETERMINATION OF THE RELATIVE RIGHTS TO THE USE OF THE WATERS OF GRANDE RONDE RIVER ABOVE THE MOUTH OF GORDON CREEK, AND ALL ITS TRIBUTARIES ABOVE SAID POINT, INCLUDING GORDON CREEK, EXCEPT MILL CREEK, HERETOFORE ADJUDICATED, IN UNION COUNTY, OREGON.

SUPPLEMENTAL FINDINGS AND REPORT OF STATE WATER BOARD

Comes now Geo. T. Cochran, on this 22nd day of June, 1921, and makes report, as State Water Superintendent of Oregon, to the Honorable J. W. Knowles, Circuit Judge of the above entitled court, of his findings upon the exceptions taken to the Findings and Order of Determination made by the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, and filed in the above entitled court, and for such report shows to the court:

That on all of the objections and exceptions, hearings were held, and each of said objections or exceptions was disposed of either by the hearing of testimony thereon, by stipulation, or by default of the parties against whom the objections were filed; the testimony, stipulations and other evidence submitted in each of the said cases has been duly considered, and from such evidence the following findings should be made:

ı.

As to all of the matters wherein C. H. Arnoldus and Earl B. York are parties, it appears that the only contest between the said parties relates to the use of the water of certain springs rising on the W2SE4 of Section 15, Tp 1 S. R. 38 E. W. M., which land is owned by Earl B. York. According to the Findings of the State Water Board, Earl B. York has the first use of the water from said springs, and inasmuch as said springs rise upon the lands of said Earl B. York, no change in the decree is made hereby.

2.

Peter Allen filed exceptions to the date of priority for the use of water on his lands as shown by the tabulation and Findings of the State Water Board. Testimony was taken on the statements of his claim as to change of date, and also as to the use of water

by other usors from the same stream, and it is found that the date as tabulated by the State Water Board is correct, and no change will be made.

Also, the date of use of water by C. S. and E. J. Dunn, successors in interest to J. S. Mitchell, and of W. J. Hunter estate and of Albert Hunter, successor in interest of H. Vehers, out of the same stream, will remain the same as tabulated in said findings.

з.

In the mutual contests filed by Andrew Anderson and Ansel Comstock, the issues were formed concerning a certain tributary of Murphy Creek known as Spring Branch, and also as to certain springs rising on the lands of Androw Anderson, and it was stipulated by and between the parties that Andrew Anderson should have the exclusive use of the spring from which said Anderson has run pipes for domestic use, and that as to the other springs rising upon his lands, and the said branch of Murphy Creek which is called Spring Branch, both parties shall have a right to the use of the waters thereof under date of 1864.

4.

As to the exceptions of Joe Clark and H. H. Taylor, wherein the parties are contesting the rights as established by the Order and Findings of the State Water Board, such exceptions were settled by stipulation herein, it being agreed by and between the parties that neither of said parties shall have any priority over the other, but that each of them shall have an equal right to the use of the waters. Spring Creek or Spring Branch, from which both parties are using water, and that each of the parties shall have the right to irrigate 20 acres with equal priority. That any other acreage irrigated by either party shall be subsequent in time to the twenty acres irrigated by the other party. That the tabulation therefore established by the State Water Board in its Findings shall remain the same but shall be modified by this stipulation as to the use of water, and the Water Waster shall divide the water equally between them for the irrigation of twenty acres each, and in case there is more water than is sufficient to irrigate forty acres, then he may give to either of the parties hereto additional water for the irrigation of other land.

5.

As to the exceptions of W. D. Grandy, the tabulation in the Findings of the State Water Board recites that W. D. Grandy receives water through the La Grando Irrigation Company Ditch. Such is an error, and such tabulation is hereby corrected.

The date of priority is left the same as found in said findings of the State Water Board.

6.

As to the exceptions of W.R. Hutchinson to the Findings as to the amount allowed for stock water, asking that the same be made more definite and certain, such findings are to be specifically applied to each individual water user, and the quantity of water for stock use shall be allowed to each owner in accordance with the number of livestock watered by him from said ditch. The amount of such water allowed for stock use shall remain as designated in said findings.

7.

The exceptions of M. O. and H. Lieurance to the fixing of the date of priority of their claim by the State Water Board as of 1865 was settled by stipulation between the water; users of Murphy Creek to the effect that Andrew Anderson, Ansel Comstock and the Lieurances should have the same date of priority for the use of water out of Murphy Creek; it appearing that Anderson and Comstock each have a date fixed of 1864, the date tabulated under the names of M. O. and H. Lieurance in the tabulation of the State Water Board shall be changed to 1864 instead of 1865, and the date of priority for distributing the water to M. O. and H. Lieurance for the lands so tabulated shall be 1864.

Exceptions of M. W. Mitchell and wife for the irrigation of ten acres described as the NW4SE4NE4 of Section 16, Tp 3 S. R. 40 from the springs rising on claimant's lands and also from springs extending to the claim of G. M. Baker, were settled by stipulation, and an additional supply of water for the irrigation of said lands is allowed from springs rising on the lands of G. M. Baker, but the use of said water from the springs rising on the lands of G. M. Baker shall in no way interfere with or prevent the use of such water upon the lands of said G. M. Baker, it being intended to give only the surplus water to said lands after the rights of said G. M. Baker to the use of such water have been satisfied.

Also as to the exceptions of the Mitchells to the claim of Emma E. Pixton, where the right to the use of water from springs rising on the lands of Emma E. Pixton is also claimed for said described land, the right to the use of such water is first given to Emma E. Pixton, and any surplus water that there may be may be used as a supplemental right upon the lands of said M. W. Mitchell and wife, in the same manner and with the same effect as the water from the springs rising on the lands of G. M. Baker.

The exceptions of the May Park Water Company ask that the tabulation of the lands irrigated thereunder be stricken from the tabulation and that the stock-holders have their rights tabulated individually accordingly as they may appear.

The tabulation, therefore, under the May Park Water Company, is stricken cut, and the stockholders are tabulated hereinafter in accordance with their rights. As to the exceptions relative to the individual members who filed, the changes are hereinafter tabulated.

10.

Edward Mitchell excepted to the Findings of the State Water Board in that they gave him a right to irrigate Block 24, Swackhamer's Second Addition to Union, out of the Lewis Ditch, when in truth and in fact it is irrigated out of the Swackhamer-Schoonover-Hutchinson Ditch, it appearing that the Lewis Ditch cannot be used for such irrigation, and the tabulation is hereby changed so as to show the irrigation of said Block 24 out of the said Swackhamer-Schoonover-Hutchinson Ditch.

11.

Mary Patton asks, as successor in interest to the rights tabulated under the name of Ada Sterzer to the use of the waters of Catherine Creek, that such land upon which said water is to be used be specifically described, and such land is therefore described as follows:

Commencing at a point 417 feet South of the Northeast corner of the NWA of the SWA of Section 19, Tp 4 S. R. 40 E. W. M., running thence South 104 feet; thence West 30 fact; thence South 12 feet; thence west 2232 feet; thence south 2212 feet; thence west 2084 feet; thence north 230 feet; thence east 2534 feet; thence north 108 feet; thence east 2082 feet to place of beginning, reserving the right, for the benefit of Union County, Oregon, to convey water across said land in a ditch located as follows: Commencing at a point 417 feet south of the said Northeast corner of the NW4 of the SW4 of Section 19, Tp 4 S. R. 40 E. W. M., thence west 94 feet; thence south 1164 feet; Also beginning at a point 30 feet east of the Northeast corner of the NW2 of the SW2 of Section 19, Tp 4 S R 40 E. W. M., thence east 511 feet; thence north 4 feet; thence west 511 feet; thence south 4 feet to the place of beginning, being a one-third interest thereon, said land being used as part of the right of way for that certain irrigation ditch and water right heretofore constructed, used and owned by one S. T. Ulm, and one N. Ficklin, and Union County, Oregon, each owning an individed one-third interest therein, the said S. T. Ulm and his successors using his and their onethird interest therein and his and their one-third of the water thereof in and upon and for irrigating the following described lands: Commencing at a point 417 foot south of the Northeast corner of the N#4 of the SW4 of Section 19, To 4 S. R. 40 E. W. M., thence west 2082 feet; thence south 1042 feet; thence west 2082 feet; thence 1041 feet to the place of beginning; also beginning at a point $521\frac{1}{4}$ feet south and 30 feet west of the said Northeast corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 19, Tp 4 S. R. 40 E. W. M., thence west $178\frac{1}{2}$ feet; thence south $3\frac{1}{4}$ feet; thence west 45 feet; thence south $8\frac{1}{4}$ feet; thonce east $223\frac{1}{2}$ feet thence North 12 feet to the place of beginning; also commencing at a point 525 feet south, 2531 feet west of the Northeast corner of the Nin of the Swi of Section 19, Tp 4 S. R. 40 E. W. M., thence south 230 feet; thence west 208 feet; thence north 230 feet; thence east 208; feet to the place of beginning; John Sylvester in his lifetime having been the successor of said S. T. Ulm, and his interest now being owned jointly by his heirs, the parties hereto,

Together with all our right, title and interest in and to said described irrigation ditch and water right, being a one-third interest; Also all our right, title and interest in any and all water ditches and water rights used to irrigate said land, or any part thereof.

12.

The exceptions of $\ensuremath{\mathbb{W}}$. J. Townley as to the Sugar Best Irrigation Company are hereby denied.

13.

Benson Brothers except to the Findings of the State Water Board for the reason that the ditches through which their land is irrigated are misnamed. It is ordered that the acreage, amounting to 92.57 acres, tabulated as irrigated from the Old Channel Ditch, shall be irrigated through the Old Channel and Perley Ditch, and the acreage, amounting to 205.86 acres, irrigated through the Old Channel and Hot Lake Ditch, shall be irrigated through the Old Channel and Hot Lake, or Benson Brothers, Ditch.

14.

Upon the petition of the administratrix of the estate of L. Brazille, deceased, it is ordered that the lands tabulated in the Findings of the State Water Board under the name of J. W. Ingram shall be in the name of the Estate of L. Brazille, deceased, said J. W. Ingram having transferred said lands to said L. Brazille prior to his death and after the filing of the statement and proof of claim for water right,

15.

As to the exceptions of J. F. Dobbin rolative to the lands irrigated by the Sugar Beet Irrigation Company, it appears that he has purchased certain lands lying West of Catherine Creek, amounting to approximately 17.73 acres in the NE-NW-1, 2.75 acres in the NW-1NE-1 of Section 10, 15.93 acres in the SE-1SW-1 and 3.6 acres in the SW-1SE-1 of Section 30, all in Tp 4 S. R. 39 E. W. M. That such lands are tabulated under the name of the Amalgamated Sugar Company as being irrigated through the Sugar Beet Irrigation Company's ditch, and it appears that J. F. Dobbin is successor in interest in the ownership of said lands, and that such water right was transferred with the land, which stands in his name, and that said water right should also stand in his name in this decree, and it is so ordered.

In the tabulation there appears certain lands tabulated under the name of G. T. Hammon, and it appears that Mr. Hammon's initials are G. F. It is therefore ordered; that said water right be changed from the name of G. T. Hammon to that of G. F. Hammon.

17.

The exceptions of the Pioneer Flouring Mill Company and the Irrigation Canal Company and E. E. Grout are settled by the decree in a suit wherein the Island City M & M Company was plaintiff and Orodell Canal Company, Irrigation Canal Company, People's Irrigation Canal Company, and City of La Grande, George Gekeler, Homer Nessley, M. Baker, L. Oldenburg, J. E. Hough, F. Gardinier, J. S. McWhirter, Georgie Messner, Jos Richardson, Frank Wessley, Charles Wessley and John Wessly were defendants. The Pioneer Flouring Mill Company is successor in interest of the plaintiff in the above entitled suit, and by such decree said Pioneer Flouring Mill Company is entitled to divert 1500 miner's inches from the Grande Ronde River for use between the first day of September of each year and the first day of July of the following year, and 100 miner's inches between the first day of July and the first day of Soptember of each year. The Orodell Canal Company is the same party as is named the Orodell Ditch Association in the tabulation in the Findings of the State Water Board, and by such decree said Orodell Ditch Association is entitled to divert 100 miner's inches between September first of each year and May first of the following year, 500 miner's inches between May first and July first of each year, and 200 miner's inches between July first and September first of each year, but at no time shall said Orodell Ditch Association divert more than half the flow of the river. By said decree the rights of the Irrigation Canal Company are all subsequent to the rights of said Picneer Flouring Kill Company, and the rights of all other defendants in said suit are subsequent to the rights of the Fioneer Flouring Mill Company.

As to the various exceptions involving the use of the waters of Warm Creek, it appears that Warm Creek flows in a westerly direction through Sections 11, 10, 9 and 8 in Tp 3 S. R. 40 E. W. M.; that in the $SE_2^1NW_2^1$ of Section 11, Warm Creek divides into two branches, the northerly branch flowing westerly through the $N_2S_2^1$ of Section 10 and the $N_2^1S_2^1$ of Section 9, and the south branch taking a southeasterly course from said point through the $NE_2^1SW_2^1$ of Section 11, and thence through the $S_2^1S_2^1$ of Section 10 and Section 9 respectively; that at a point on the $SE_2^1SE_2^1$ of Section 10, the south branch of Warm Creek

again divides and the most southerly branch thereof for a distance flows through the NNNV of Section 15. The use of water from all of these branches has been in a way to take and use all of the water that might come down either branch, and in some instances water users have gone to the point where the stream divides and turned all the water down either one or the other of the branches, according as to which branch such water user would be using the water from. In the development of the lands, about the same amount of water has been used upon the lands irrigated from the north fork as has been used upon the lands irrigated from the south fork. Springs arising along the stream and upon the lands irrigated from the stream supplement the supply from each of the creeks, and at low water time of the creek, in many instances supply all of the water used for irrigation upon certain particular pieces of land. appears, therefore, that the water should be divided equally at the division point in the SE4NW4 of Section 11, and it is therefore ordered that division boxes be placed at the dividing point of said stream by the water users interested, and that such division boxes be placed in accordance with the plans and specifications to be furnished by the Water Master, and under his supervision, and such division boxes shall be so placed as to divide the water equally between the north and south branches of said stream.

As to the division point in the SEASE of Section 10, it appears that a number of years ago a part of the northerly branch of said south branch was covered over with a conduit to carry the water, and that the water for the Dean place in the SW2SW2 of Section 10 was run down through this conduit, and the balance of the water went through the most southerly branch of the stream; that for the irrigation of the Payne estate in the NW2 of Section 15, ditches were dug from the most northerly of said branches of the south branch of Warm Creek and diversion made in the SELSWL of Section 10, and carried in a southerly direction to the most southerly branch, and onto the lands of the Payne estate. Such diversion will be subject to the water needs of the Dean lands in the SW SW of said Section 10, and any diversion made by the Conklin estate from the most northerly branch of said south fork of Warm Creek would be subject to their rights. In order to provide such rights, it appears that Dean should have the right to repair and place in good condition the conduit through which Warm Creek has heretofore flowed water for the irrigation of his lands, and that not more than one-fourth of the water of Warm Creek should be diverted through that conduit; and if there is more water in said stream than necessary for use upon the Dean lands, then the Conklin estate shall have the right to divort that extra amount.

As between Stacklund and Love, the dates of priority will control the distribution of water, and such dates of priority will remain the same as fixed in the Findings of the State Water Board. The nature of use upon the lands shall be left to the owner of each of the pieces of land.

The exceptions of L. M. Wilson are denied, and his right shall remain as defined in the Findings of the State Water Board. It appears, however, that the waters of Ladd Creek should be divided between the two branches thereof. The said Ladd Creek flows in a northerly direction, and upon emerging from the canyon in which it arises it divides into two branches called the east branch and the west branch, and the waters of Ladd Creek should be divided equally between the two said branches. Upon the water users of said Ladd Creek defraying the expenses, a concrete division box should be installed at the forks of said creek, under the supervision and specifications of the Water Master.

19.

That the following claims were filed, all of which were not filed in the original proceedings, and are herewith tabulated as an addition to the tabulation as appears in the original Findings of the State Water Board. Such tabulation contains the name of the appropriator, his post office address, the date of relative priority, the number of acres, the use or uses to which the water was applied and is now applied, and to which said use is limited; the name of the ditch or ditches through which the water is diverted, the name of the stream or streams from which such water is diverted, and the description of the land upon which such water is used. The tabulated rights of each appropriator are set opposite and following the name and post office address of such appropriator, in columns, as follows, to-wit:

That F. H. Johnson, D. W. Murchison, J. H. Patrick and Jerry Veatch appeared in the proceedings and desired to file a stipulation relative to the use of water from McDonald Creek, a tributary of Grande Ronde River, and thereupon did file such a stipulation; and from such stipulation it appears that each party shall pay his pro rata expense toward the keeping up of the ditch from which he uses water, and if only one party uses water from such ditch, then he shall keep it up himself. That Jerry Veatch has the first right to the use of the water of said creek in the same manner and to the same extent as he now uses it. That the other users of water shall use the same equally in proportion to the number of acres irrigated, and the Water Master of the County shall have the right to arrange a system of rotation between the users so as to best conserve and use the water, and as nearly as possible give to each party the time of use in proportion to the number of acres that he irrigates.

That subject to these provisions, their rights are tabulated as follows, and under the same heading as other tabulations herein:
