FINDINGS AND ORDER OF DETERMINATION.

Now, on this 22nd day of January, 1912, the above entitled matter coming on for the consideration of the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, upon the evidence and proofs herein, for Findings and Order of Determination of the relative rights to the waters of said above named stream, and the said Board having now considered said evidence and proofs and the testimony and documents and instruments filed herein, and being now fully advised in the premises, FINDS and ORDERS as follows, to-wit:

I.

That on the 24th day of May, 1909, a proper petition praying for an adjudication of the relative rights to the waters of said Butter Creek, a tributary of the Umatilla River, in Umatilla and Morrow Counties, Oregon, signed by J. B. Saylor, Allen Thomson, W. A. Thomson, and R. B. Stanfield, water users on said stream, was duly filed with the Board of Control of the State of Oregon; that thereafter, and on the 7th day of May, 1909, a petition praying for the adjudication of the relative rights to the waters of the Umatilla River, a tributary of the Columbia River, signed by Oliver P. Morton for and on behalf of the United States of America, was duly filed with the Board of Control of the State of Oregon.

II.

That upon an investigation, the said Board of Control found Butter Creek to be a tributary of the Umatilla River, and that the facts and conditions were such as to justify the making of a determination of the relative rights of the various claimants to the waters of the Umatilla River, and its tributaries, including said Butter Creek; and thereupon, by an order duly made and entered on the 7th day of March, 1910, fixed the 9th day of May, 1910, as the time when the State Engineer of the State of Oregon would begin the investigation of the flow of said stream and of the ditches diverting water therefrom, and the 16th day of May, 1910, in the town of Echo, Umatilla County, Oregon, and the 19th day of May, 1910, in the City of Pendleton, in Umatilla County, Oregon, as the times when and the places where the Superintendent of Water Division No. 2 would begin the taking of testimony and proofs as to the relative rights of the various claimants to the waters of said stream.

III.

That pursuant to said Order, a notice setting forth the date when the State Engineer of the State of Oregon would begin the investigation of the flow of said stream, and of the ditches diverting water therefrom, to wit: the 9th day of May, 1910; and the times when and places where the Super-

intendent of Water Division No. 2, in which division said stream is situate, would begin the taking of testimony as to the rights of the parties claiming water therefrom, to-wit: on Monday, the 16th day of May, A. D. 1910, at the hour of 10 o'clock A. M., in that certain building known as the City Hall, in the town of Edio, Umatilla County, Oregon, and on Thursday, the 19th day of May, A. D. 1910, at the hour of 10 o'clock A. M., in the Circuit Court room, in the County Court House, in the City of Pendleton, Umatilla County, Oregon, was duly and regularly published in two issues of the East Oregonian, a newspaper printed and published at Pendleton, in the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, and having a general circulation within said County of Umatilla, to-wit: beginning with the 25th day of March, 1910, and ending on the 1st day of April, 1910; due proof of such publication in said newspaper being now on file in the office of the Board of Control and a part of the record herein; that a like notice was also duly and regularly published for two consecutive weeks in the Heppner Gazette, a newspaper printed and published in the County of Morrow, State of Oregon, and having a general circulation within said County of Morrow, to-wit: beginning with March 31st, 1910, and ending with the issue dated April 7th, 1910, due proof of such publication in said newspaper being now on file in the office of the Board of Control and a part of the record herein; that said Superintendent of Water Division No. 2 did, on the 5th day of April, 1910, send, by registered mail, a similar notice to each and every person, firm, or corporation, claiming the right to the use of any of the waters of said stream, or its tributaries, and to each and every person, firm or corporation owning or being in possession of lands bordering on or having access to said stream, or its tributaries, in so far as such claimants could be reasonably ascertained, and that said superintendent did enclose with said notice a blank form on which said claimant, owner, person, firm, or corporation in possession should present in writing all of the particulars necessary for the determination of his rights to the waters of said stream to which he lays claim, due proof whereof being now on file in the office of the Board of Control and a part of the record herein.

IV.

That pursuant to such notice, a duly qualified assistant to the State Engineer did proceed to make an examination of said stream and of the works diverting water therefrom, and an examination and approximate measurement of the lands irrigated and susceptible of irrigation from said ditches and canals, which said measurements and observations have been reduced to writing and made a matter of record in the office of the State Engineer of the State of Oregon; and that said Superintendent of Water Division No. 2 did, at the time and place in said notice specified, take the testimony and proofs of claimants to the waters of said stream, said claimants being hereinafter named in the findings as to their respective rights, due proof of such hearing being now on file herein, and a part of the record in this cause.

V.

That upon the completion of the taking of testimony and proofs aforesaid by the said Superintendent of Water Division No. 2, he did, on the 8th day of August, 1910, give notice to each of the claimants to the waters of said stream (hereinafter named in the Findings as to their respective rights) by registered mail, that all of the evidence, testimony and proofs of the various claimants would be open to inspection for a period of seventeen days (Sundays excepted), beginning on Monday the 5th day of September, 1910, and ending on Friday, the 23rd day of September, 1910, from 9 A. M. to 12 A. M., and from 1:30 P. M. to 5 P. M., at the Commissioner's Court Room, in the County Court House, in Pendleton, Umatilla County, Oregon; and that the determination of the Board of Control would be heard by the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County; due proof whereof and of the mailing of said notices by registered mail being now on file in this cause.

VI.

That pursuant to said notice, the said Division Superintendent did, at the time and place in said notice specified, hold such inspection, due proof whereof being now on file herein.

VII.

That all evidence, testimony and proofs filed with the said Superintendent in the above entitled matter have been transmitted by him in person to the office of the said Board of Control and are now on file in said office.

VIII.

That the following named persons, firms and corporations were duly notified as declared in Finding No. III herein, but that each and all of them have failed, neglected and refused to file any claim to the waters of said stream, and are in default herein and have no interest in, or claim to, the waters of said stream; said persons, firms and corporations so being in default herein, with their respective postoffice addresses, being as follows, to-wit:

IX.

hereof
That on the 5th day of November, 1911, a petition was duly filed with the Board of Control of the State of Oregon praying that said Board of Control settle, adjudicate and determine the relative rights to the waters of Butter Creek separate and apart from the determination of the relative rights to the waters of Umatilla River; that upon investigation the said Board of Control finds that the facts and conditions surrounding the said adjudication and determination of the relative rights to the waters of Umatilla River, and its tributaries, are such as to justify the taking up of the determination of the relative rights to the waters of Butter Creek separate and apart from said determination of the relative rights to the waters of the Umatilla River.

X.

That said Butter Creek is a natural watercourse, rising in said Umatilla County, Oregon, and flowing thence to the Umatilla River, of which it is a tributary; that said Butter Creek is entirely situate in ^{and Morrow} Umatilla Counties; that said Butter Creek as a usual thing goes dry sometime during the month of July of each year and remains dry until the fall rains begin, and in dry years goes dry sometimes as early as the 1st of June.

XI.

That the soil of the irrigable lands lying along said stream is chiefly of a sandy and volcanic ash formation, and is chiefly cultivated to gardens, hay and grain.

XII.

That each of the appropriations of water for the purpose of irrigation hereinafter set forth is limited to an amount of water sufficient for the irrigation and reclamation of the lands described herein as being the lands to which such water is appurtenant, and the total volume of water so appropriated and hereby confirmed in each case shall not exceed a total of four acre feet for each acre of land irrigated, which amount shall be diverted from the stream at not to exceed the rate of flow herein fixed, except as hereinafter set forth and specified. The use of water for irrigation purposes shall be confined to the irrigation season beginning with January 1st and ending with September 1st of each year.

XIII.

The Board of Control of the State of Oregon finds that in the irrigation of the lands along said stream, it is necessary that each irrigator have a sufficient head of water to get the stream of water upon the land and to irrigate the same quickly, and that it is the custom of all of the irrigators along said stream to take a large head of water into their ditches and run the same for a sufficient length of time to wet their lands, and then shut off the water, and that the irrigation is mostly carried on during the floods of said stream; that many of said irrigators depend entirely upon the floods of the said stream and use their entire quota of water during said time; that in order to accommodate this settlement and adjudication of water rights to the customs and necessities of the use of water along said stream, the water master of the district in which such water is situated, shall arrange such system, or systems, of rotation as may be best applicable, either by giving a greater amount of water to an appropriator for a proportionately less time, or by arranging such appropriators in groups or systems for such rotation, first giving the appropriator who is first in priority an amount of water equal to the combined appropriations of all the appropriators in said group or system for a length of time bearing the same ratio to the whole time required to make complete rotation through the whole group or system as the appropriation of the said first appropriator bears to the combined appropriations of said appropriators, and shall serve the next appropriator in priority next, with a like amount of water for his proportionate time and so on, until all the appropriators in said group are served; then the distribution of water shall be repeated in the same manner throughout the irrigating season; that in case any two or more appropriators in said group shall have the same priorities, then the said watermaster shall distribute the water as between those appropriators having the same priorities to the one whose ditch taps the stream nearest its source, first, and the next lower down, next, and so on; and where two or more appropriators agree as between themselves as to a manner and system of rotation in the use of their water, the said water master shall distribute their water in accordance with such agreement; that in case said stream goes dry in some parts thereof, or the water gets so low as not to reach down the stream to a part of the appropriators, then the watermaster shall distribute said water to such appropriators as can make a beneficial use thereof; provided, and this whole Finding No. XIII is upon the condition that such arrangement into groups and systems shall not interfere with the prior rights of any appropriator not a member of such group or system.

XIV.

That the following contests were filed, to-wit: E. O. Neill, and L. D. Neill, contestants, v. R. F. Wiglesworth, contestee; E. O. Neill and L. D. Neill, contestants, v. R. F. Wiglesworth and I. C. Cox, contestees; E. O. Neill and L. D. Neill, contestants, v. W. W. Howard, contestee; E. O. Neill and

L. D. Neill, contestants, v. R. F. and W. E. Wigglesworth, contestees; E. O. Neill and L. D. Neill, contestants, v. Kate Cornett, contestee; E. O. Neill and L. D. Neill, contestants, v. George J. Curran, contestee; and E. O. Neill and L. D. Neill, contestants, v. Charles H. Bartholomew, contestee; that each and all of said contests were settled by stipulation and agreement of the parties and dismissed; that said stipulation was and is to the effect that neither of the contestants or contestees herein named, claimed any right superior to the right of the other parties, and in accordance with said stipulation, in the distribution of the waters of said stream, the water master of the district in which said water is situate shall so distribute said water.

XV.

That claimant, Saylor-Thomson Water & Construction Company, has filed a claim before the Board of Control to the effect that said claimant is diverting water by a ditch from Five Mile Creek and putting the same into Butter Creek, and that they desire to use the water which they divert from Five Mile Creek and put into Butter Creek on certain lands in section 1, township 2 north range 27 east, W. M.; and in sections 25 and 36, township 3 north range 27 east, W. M., and in sections 30 and 31, township 3 north range 28 E. W. M.; and that said claimant desires to use the natural channel of said Butter Creek to convey said water so diverted from Five Mile Creek to the vicinity of those said lands, and then divert said water from the natural channel of said Butter Creek by a ditch to the said lands; upon receipt of notice in writing, giving the date when it is proposed to discharge water from Five Mile Creek into Butter Creek, the volume of water so discharged, and the names of all persons and ditches entitled to its use, and the proper installation of measuring devices for measuring such water, the water master of the district in which such water is situate shall measure said water into Butter Creek and so adjust the headgates of all ditches upon the stream or watercourse not entitled to the use of such water from Five Mile Creek as will enable those having the right to secure the volume of such water to which they are entitled, and said water master shall measure such volume of water to the persons so entitled to the same, less such an amount as said watermaster may determine has been lost by seepage and evaporation. This Finding shall not give said claimant Saylor-Thomson Water & Construction Company any right or title in and to the waters of Butter Creek other than as hereinbefore set forth, nor shall this determination affect any rights as may appear in any future determination of the relative rights to the waters of Five Mile Creek.

XVI.

That the name and address of each appropriator of water from said Butter Creek, arranged alphabetically, together with the date of relative priority of each such appropriation, the maximum amount of such appropriation in cubic feet per second of time, the number of acres to which such appropriation is applied and to which such water is appurtenant, the use or uses for which such water was appropriated and is now applied, and to which such use is limited, the name of the ditch or ditches through which such appropriation is diverted, the name of the stream or tributary from which the water is taken, and a description of the legal subdivisions in which such irrigated land is situated, with the number of acres in each such legal subdivision, and to which land such water right is appurtenant, arranged in tabulated form and set opposite the name and postoffice address of each of such appropriators, are as follows, to-wit:

BUTTER CREEK.

XVII.

That all appropriations of water from said stream and its tributaries, as found in Finding No. XVI herein, are limited to a beneficial use by the appropriators for the purposes therein specified, and not to exceed the maximum rate as therein fixed.

XVIII.

That the use of water for domestic purposes includes household use and water for livestock throughout the year.

XIX.

That all appropriations of water from said stream for domestic purposes, as found in Finding No. XVI herein, are limited to a sufficient amount for the needs of the appropriator not to exceed the rate of one-fortieth cubic foot per second of time for each one thousand head of stock; provided that the amount of water for irrigation specified in Finding No. XVI herein includes the water for domestic purposes to which said appropriation is entitled during the irrigation season.

By order of the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, made and entered at an adjourned, regular meeting of said Board, commenced on the 15th day of November, A. D. 1911, and adjourned until January 22nd, 1912, at Salem, Oregon.
