SUPPLEMENTAL DECREE
IN RE LOST AND BOUL-
DER DITCH

And comes now on the above entitled matter for further consideration, for final determination of the water rights of claimants using the waters of White River and its tributaries, a tributary of the Deschutes River, from the Lost and Boulder Ditch, and it appearing that the State Engineer of the State of Oregon has heretofore on July 1, 1931, filed his Findings in relation to the claims of the water users under and from the Lost and Boulder Ditch and from said Findings and based thereon, the Court does hereby further order, adjudge and decree as follows:

That subject to the general provisions of the Findings and Order of the State Water Board (now State Engineer) heretofore made in this proceeding, as modified by the decree of the Circuit Court for Wasco County entered on the 30th day of November, 1923, the following named claimants using water from the Lost and Boulder Ditch are entitled to a decree herein and to the issuance of a water right certificate in accordance therewith, determining and establishing their respective rights to the use of the waters of said stream with a date of priority as of the year of 1911 for the irrigation of 659.20 acres of land diverted through the Lost and Boulder Ditch; said water to be used on the acreage set forth and described opposite their respective names in the following tabulated statement, to-wit:
