FINDINGS OF FACT AND ORDER OF DETERMINATION.

Now on this 22nd day of January, 1913, the above entitled matter coming on before the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, at an adjourned meeting of said Board, commenced and held on said day, there were present: - John H. Lewis, President; James T. Chinnock and Geo. T. Cochran, Superintendents, and it appearing to the said Board, that all the evidence in the original hearing before the Superintendent of Water Division No. 2, and all the evidence taken in all contests, has been transmitted by said Superintendent to the office of the Board of Control, in person, and the said Board, having carefully considered all of the said evidence, statements, proofs and testimony and also the information and data gathered, compiled and reduced to writing by the State Engineer and made a matter of record in the office of said State Engineer, a certified copy of which, including duly certified copies of maps or plats, made and prepared according to law, has been filed with said Board, and being now fully advised in the premises, makes and orders to be entered of record in its office, the following

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1.

That on the 28th day of June, 1909, there was filed in the office of the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, a petition, signed by the Peoples Irrigation Co., by O. C. McDowell, Mgr., water users upon the stream aforesaid, requesting the determination of the relative rights of the various claimants to the waters of said stream. That thereupon, the Board of Control made an investigation and found the facts and conditions such as to justify the making of a determination of said rights. That on the 13th day of April, 1910, said Board of Control made an order and entered the same in Volume 1, page 58 of the Record of Proceedings of the Board of Control, which said order fixed the time when the State Engineer or his assistant would begin the examination of said stream, to-wit: Monday, the 17th day of October, 1910, and also the time when the Superintendent of Water Division No. 2 would begin the taking of testimony to enable said Board to determine the rights of said stream, to-wit: Tuesday, the 18th day of October, 1910, at the hour of 10 o'clock A. M., at the Postoffice in the town of Paulina, Crook County, Oregon; and on Thursday, the 20th day of October, 1910, at the hour of 10 o'clock A. M., at the Circuit Court room in the Court house at Prineville, Oregon. That thereupon, based upon said order, said Board of Control prepared a notice, setting forth the date when the State Engineer or his assistant would begin an investigation of the flow of said stream and of the ditches diverting water therefrom and the place and time when the Superintendent of Water Division No. 2 would begin the taking of testimony as to the rights of the parties claiming water therefrom. That said notice was published in two issues of the Crook County Journal, a newspaper published at Prineville, Crook County, Oregon, and having general circulation in the counties in which said stream is situated, the first publication being on the 8th day of September, 1910, and the last publication of said notice being on the 15th day of September, 1910, and more than thirty days prior to the beginning of taking testimony by said Division Superintendent and the measurement of said stream by said State Engineer or his assistant. That on the 13th day of September, 1910, the Superintendent of Water Division No. 2, did send by registered mail to each person, firm and corporation, claiming the right to the use of any

of the waters of said stream, and to each person, firm, and corporation owning or being in possession of lands bordering on and having access to said stream or its tributaries in so far as such claimants, owners, persons, firms and corporations in possession could be reasonably ascertained, a similar notice setting forth said date when the State Engineer or his assistant would begin the examination of the stream and the ditches diverting the waters therefrom, and also the date when and the place where said Superintendent would take testimony as to the rights to the waters of said stream. That said notice was mailed more than thirty days prior to said dates set therein for making said examination of said stream and the taking of said testimony. That said Division Superintendent did, in addition, enclose with said notice, a blank form on which said claimant or owner should present in writing and under oath all the particulars necessary for the determination of his right to the waters of the stream to which he lays claim. That due proof of the publication and the registered mailing of said notices has been made and filed herein. That upon the dates named in said notices so published and mailed and at the places specified therein, a duly appointed qualified and acting assistant to the State Engineer did commence said examination, and the Superintendent of Water Division No. 2 did begin the taking of said testimony and did continue the taking of the same until completed, to-wit: the 16th day of July, 1911. That the observations and measurements made by said assistant to the State Engineer were reduced to writing and made a matter of record in the office of said State Engineer, and said State Engineer caused to be made maps or plats as provided by law, blue prints and duly certified copies of said observations measurements, maps and plats being now on file herein and a part of the record hereof. That the following named persons, firms and corporations were duly notified as aforesaid, but that each and all of them have failed, neglected and refused to appear herein and submit proof of their rights or claim to the waters of said stream, if any they have, and that each of said parties are in default herein, and said default should be and hereby is entered against said parties, to-wit: Wm. Wood, Road Land Agent, Clarence Wiley, James Zimmerly, Alex Zeverly, and it is considered, ordered and decreed that each and every of said parties, so in default, be and he is hereby barred and estopped from hereafter asserting any rights acquired upon said stream previous to February 24th, 1909, and all rights to the use of said water claimed by each of said parties previous to said date have been and by said default are forfeited.

II.

That upon the completion of the taking of testimony and on the 17th day of July, 1911, the Superintendent of Water Division No. 2, gave notice by registered mail to the various claimants, being all claimants who filed statements and gave testimony in this proceeding, that at a time and place named in said notice, to-wit: beginning on Monday, the 7th day of August, 1911, and ending on Friday, the 18th day of August, 1911, being for a period of ten days, Sunday excepted, at the Court house in Prineville, Crook County, Oregon, all of said evidence would be open to inspection of the various claimants or owners. That said notice also stated that the determination of the Board of Control would be heard by the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County being the County in which said stream is situate. That on the dates and at the place named in said notice said Division Superintendent did, in pursuance of said notice, attend and keep said evidence open to inspection. Due proof of said mailing of notices and of holding said inspection is filed herein. That on or before the 23rd day of

August, 1911, and within five days after the close of said inspection, the following contests were filed, to-wit;

III.

That in the contest of C. L. Ream, contestant, vs. Lucy H. Anderson, contestee, a notice of hearing of said contest at the Court House in Prineville, Crook County, Oregon, at 10 o'clock A. M., on Monday, the 22nd day of July, 1912, was served upon said Lucy H. Anderson, contestee, on the 8th day of June, 1912, due proof of which is on file herein. That on said 22 day of July, 1912, the Superintendent of Water Division No. 2, attended at said place so set in said notice and the said Lucy H. Anderson did not attend, either in person or by attorney. That contestant C. L. Ream attended and offered testimony upon said contest, and based on said testimony, the Board of Control finds that the rights of said Lucy H. Anderson, contestee, to the use of water out of Drake Creek, are subsequent in time to the rights of said contestant, C. L. Ream and the dates of relative priority are as stated in the tabulation herein.

IV.

In the contests of Francis V. Smith, contestant vs. J. E. Adamson, contestee; Ochoco & Rye Grass Irrigation Company, contestant vs. C. M. Elkins, contestee; Ochoco & Rye Grass Irrigation Company, contestant vs. C. Sam Smith and Francis V. Smith, contestees; Ochoco & Rye Grass Irrigation Company contestant vs. William H. Grimes, contestee; Ochoco & Rye Grass Irrigation Company, contestant, vs. John M. Elliott, contestee; and Ochoco & Rye Grass Irrigation Company, contestant, vs. Robert M. Templeton, contestee, the following findings are made:-

That the Ochoco & Rye Grass Irrigation Company is a public service corporation engaged in the business of carrying and delivering water along the line of its ditch to water users for the purpose of irrigation; that in the year 1897, O. M. Pringle went upon McKay and Ochoco Creeks and appropriated 3,000 miner's inches of water for the purpose of irrigating the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 16, Tp. 14 S. R. 15 E. W. M., and other lands along the line of his ditch; that in

making said appropriation said Pringle intended that said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section should have a priority of right; that to secure rights-of-way and also labor to construct the ditch, said Pringle made contracts to deliver water to C. M. Elkins, John M. Elliott and others; that about the year 1901, said Pringle sold said ditch to the Ochoco & Rye Grass Irrigation Company, which company has continued to sell and deliver said water to water users along the line of its ditch under annual contracts; that it is the duty of said Ochoco & Rye Grass Irrigation Company and to that end said company shall make contracts to supply water to any and all persons applying to said company for water to be used for irrigation purposes along the line of said ditch or whose lands can be reasonably supplied with water from said ditch under reasonable and uniform contracts and for reasonable and uniform charges up to the limit of the capacity of the ditch of said company, so long as said person complies or is ready and able to comply with the terms of such contract, provided always that water shall be supplied to water users in the order of and according to the date which the land upon which the water is to be used was first supplied with water from said ditch which said dates are set out in the tabulation herein or will be set out in State Engineer's permits and water right certificates issued subsequent to February 24, 1909, and subject always to the general provisions of this decree as to rotation, and provided further that said company shall not contract to deliver water to lands not theretofore supplied by said company to such an extent as to deprive any lands of water which had been formerly supplied and provided further that said company shall not contract to sell and deliver any water to any land unless said land have a right to the use of water by this decree, by a State Engineer's permit or by a water right certificate and provided further that said company may cut off and refuse to deliver water to any water user who fails or refuses to comply with lawful contracts as herein provided; that all contracts for the use of water made between any water user, or land owner and said company giving any preference other than as herein stated or as in this decree generally provided in Finding XVIII if said company so elect, are against the public policy and laws of the State of Oregon and void. That William H. Grimes made application to withdraw his claim and upon the condition that the contest against him be dismissed but it was agreed that he could purchase water from said company. That said claim was not withdrawn and said application to withdraw is a waiver of his date of priority and said Grimes shall have the right to purchase water for said lands described in said claim, from said company as of date of July, 1912. That C. M. Elkins acquired a water right through said ditch at the time it was built under the conditions as set forth in a stipulation filed herein, and the foregoing finding with a priority date of 1896. In the spring of 1905 Charles Carroll settled upon the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 31, Twp. 14, S., R.16, E. W. M., under lease from Charles Altschul and commenced to irrigate lands thereon under contract with the Ochoco & Rye Grass Irrigation Company. That said lease was transferred until it came into the ownership of J. E. Adamson. In April, 1911, Frances V. Smith and her husband, C. Sam Smith, purchased said land from Charles Altschul or his successor in interest, but no transfer of water rights or improvements was made by Adamson to Smith. Adamson then purchased the Southeast quarter, Section Twenty-five, Township Fourteen, South, Range Fifteen, E.W.M., and began using water thereon under an arrangement with the Irrigation Company changing the place of use of said water. Neither Charles Altschul, nor his predecessor, nor his successors in interest, other than as aforesaid, made any attempt to appropriate water for said land. Not having purchased the possessory rights from Adamson, Smith did not succeed to his rights; but Smith having contracted for water beginning with the year 1911, his date of priority is herein tabulated as of that date. That J. E. Adamson has done everything possible to transfer said right, and his priority date is herein tabulated as of 1905. That John M. Elliott is a wateruser of said ditch with a priority date of 1899. That George J. Dickson has succeeded to the rights of Robert M. Templeton and is entitled to use water as of priority dates as tabulated herein.

V.

In the contest of The McKay Irrigation Company, contestant, vs. The Ochoco & Rye Grass Irrigation Company, contestee, the Board of Control finds that contestant owns appropriation rights from McKay Creek under date of 1898 for 100 acres and under date of 1904 for 240 acres of land, and contestee through its predecessors in interest appropriated sufficient water from McKay Creek to irrigate 120 acres in 1897; that contestee's right to water from McKay Creek in addition to this amount is subsequent in time and inferior in right to appropriations of contestant for 100 acres of land and prior in time and superior in right for the bal-

ance of the appropriation. That contestee's rights to water from Ochoco Creek are not involved in this contest. That contestee uses its appropriations from McKay Creek and Ochoco Creek together, one supplementing the other, and subject to the rights of contestant and other prior appropriators has the right to take all the water to which said contestee has a right from either stream or both together as conditions may require, but always in a manner to least injure subsequent appropriators. That the dates of priority of contestant and contestee are as set out in the tabulation of rights herein.

VI.

That the contest of F. M. Smith and J. L. Smith, contestants vs. T. H. Brennan, contestee, was settled by stipulation and the tabulation herein states the rights of the parties as based on said stipulation. That the contest of E. B. Knox, contestant vs. Susan E. Gibson was dismissed. That in the contest of W. W. Brown, contestant, vs. John Davin, contestee, contestee was served with notice of hearing by publication, it appearing to the Superintendent of Water Division No. 2 that said contestee was out of the State of Oregon and residing in St. Bonnett, Canton de St. Bonnett, Hautes Alps, France; that a copy of said notice of hearing together with a copy of the notice of contest was duly mailed to said contestee at said place of residence on the 21st day of August, 1912, due proof of which is filed herein, and said notice of hearing was published for ten consecutive weeks in the Crook County Journal, a newspaper of general circulation in Crook County and published at Prineville, Oregon, beginning with the issue of 29th day of August, 1912, and ending with the issue of the 7th day of November, 1912, due proof of which is filed herein; That upon the day set in said notice, to-wit: the 11th day of November, 1912, and pursuant thereto said Superintendent of Water Division No. 2, attended at the place named in said notice, to-wit: the Courthouse in Prineville, Oregon; that contestant appeared and submitted proof upon said contest; that contestee appeared not, either in person or by attorney; and based upon said testimony the Board of Control finds that contestee began using water out of Grindstone Creek in 1891 and the tabulation of rights herein is in accordance with this finding.

VII.

That the contest of E. T. Slayton and T. H. Lafollette, contestants vs. Henry S. Cram was settled by stipulation and the rights of contestee set out in the tabulation herein in accordance therewith.

VIII.

That in the contest of B. F. Allen, contestant, vs. R. M. Powell, contestee, it was stipulated that contestant was entitled to 2/3 of the flow and contestee 1/3 of the flow in the Davis ditches. That the appropriation for Davis Ditch #1 was made in 1889 and for Davis Ditch #2 in 1896. That in 1904 contestee increased his acreage to 111 acres; that the tabulation of rights herein is made upon the basis as herein found.

IX

That no proof was offered by contestant in the contest of Ochoco & Rye Grass Irrigation Company, contestant, vs. City of Prineville, Oregon, contestee, and the same was dismissed.

X.

That in the contest of E. T. Slayton contestant, vs. James W. Elliott, contestee, it was stipulated that contestee's claim be reduced to 159.87 acres, and contestee's rights are so tabulated herein.

XI.

That in the contest of Wallace Post, et.al., contestants, vs. David F. Stewart and J. W. Carlson, contestees, it was stipulated that acreage and dates of appropriation of contestants be admitted and that the date of appropriation and the amount of water used be admitted as to all the times except between July 1st and September 15th of each year and the only questions to be litigated in said contest be as to the right of priority to the use of water by contestants between said dates. That at all times since contestants and each of them began irrigating, said contestants and each of them have used the water of Crooked River and its tributaries during said time regardless of any rights that contestees had to the use of said water. That in addition to the water used by contestants there was a flow in said river sufficient for partially running the mill of contestees. That contestees operated said mill at times during this period by damming the water of the river and holding it until a sufficient head of water was secured to operate said mill for a short period; at other times just the chopper or elevator was operated. That contestees or their predecessors in interest, had notified some of contestants to turn water off their fields and let it come down the stream for the mill, but that said contestants refused so to do. That each of said contestants who have used the water for more than ten years have acquired by the statute of limitations a prior right to the use of said water during said period; that in the tabulation of rights herein, all water users named therein who take water out of said stream or its tributaries above the intake of said contestees and have been taking said water since prior to the year 1902, have acquired such prior right.

XII.

That all contestees in the foregoing contests, were duly served with the Notice of Hearing of such contest proceeding. That said notice required each and every one of said contestees to appear before the Superintendent of Water Division No. 2 in the Courthouse in Prineville, Oregon, at the several dates respectively named therein; that pursuant to said Notices of Hearing of said contests and from Monday, the 22nd day of July, 1912, until Saturday, the 27th day of July, 1912, and on Monday the 11th day of November, 1912, said Superintendent did attend and take the testimony in each and every one of said contests. That said testimony was duly taken in shorthand and fully transcribed and filed by said Superintendent as a part of the record of these proceedings.

XIII.

That Crooked River and its tributaries form a perennial stream with well defined bed and banks, wholly within Crook, Wheeler, Grant, and Harney counties, but principally within Crook County, Oregon, having its source near the eastern boundary of Crook County and flowing in a westerly direction and empties its waters in the Deschutes River. That the flow of this stream is torrential in its nature, flowing large quantities in the spring time when the winter snows are melting and almost going dry in the dry part of the summer time and almost all the tributaries do go dry. That it is necessary, therefore, to use the water for irrigation during the flood time or the irrigators will not be able to divert any water whatever. That the spring freshets begin at a different time each year, depending upon the time of the breakup of winter and its quantity and duration is dependent upon the extent of the snowfall, the time when and the degree of temperature prevailing while the winter snows are melting; that winter seldom breaks up earlier than the first of February of each year. That it is customary among irrigators to use water so long as they can get it. That sometimes some of them get water as late as December 1st. That the irrigation season, therefore, lasts from February 1st until December 1st of each year.

XIV.

That the soil of the watershed of Crooked River varies. That in places there is sandy loam, other places gravelly loam, others sagebrush and desert land, also black loam. That there is a great deal of alkali. That irrigation is necessary in order to produce crops; that four acre feet of water per acre is a sufficient amount of water for such irrigation.

XV.

That a statement and proof of claim for water right was filed by Charles Altschul by C. E. S. Wood, his agent, but that said claim is too indefinite to ascertain what right said Charles Altschul has. That said claim is for riparian rights for lands granted by the United States for the purpose of building a military road; that said company has never used any water but has leased land to tenants who have used water on the land rented by them. That such use of water has been claimed by said tenants and tabulated so far as claimed. That by reason of said non usage under claim of riparian rights and of such usage under claim of appropriation, said Charles Altschul has lost and forfeited any and all rights by riparian ownership in, of or to the waters of said stream.

XVI.

That all claimants herein to water for irrigation shall be entitled to use such water for stock and domestic purposes; that the rights of use for stock and domestic purposes hereby confirmed entitle the owner of such right to divert and use such quantity of water as is reasonably necessary for his household and stock use; and for stock use, the amount so diverted and used shall not exceed the rate of one-fortieth ($1/40$) cubic foot per second for each one thousand (1,000) head of stock; and the quantity diverted for irrigation purposes during the irrigation season shall include when it is so diverted such amount as may be reasonably necessary for said stock and domestic purposes; and the right to divert and use the waters of said stream, and its tributaries, for stock and domestic purposes continues throughout the year.

XVII.

That in order to irrigate the lands, it is necessary to have a sufficient head of water; that four acre feet is sufficient water to irrigate each acre of land and a flow of $1/80$ of a second foot^{per acre} of water for $5 \frac{1}{3}$ months will deliver said four acre feet; ^(Stricken out by Court. See p. 449 of this volume.) that the water master of the district in which said stream is situated shall in no case limit the diversion of any water user under this decree to a flow for irrigation purposes of less than $1/80$ of one second foot for each acre of land irrigated.) That said water master shall arrange such system or systems of rotation as may be best applicable without infringement on other prior rights, to-wit: either (1) by giving a greater flow of water than said $1/80$ of one second foot to an appropriator for a proportionately less time than said $5 \frac{1}{3}$ months, provided that the amount of water taken by any appropriator does not exceed four acre feet during any year; and provided further that no appropriator take more than one acre foot in ^{period of thirty} any one days; or (2) where two or more appropriators agree as between themselves as to the manner and system of rotation in the use of water, by distributing the water in accordance with such agreement; or (3) in the absence of any such agreement, by arranging such appropriators in groups, or systems of rotation, first giving the appropriator who is first in priority a quantity of water equal to the combined appropriations of all the appropriators in said group or system, for a length of time bearing the same ratio to the wholetime required to make the complete rotation through the whole group of appropriators as the appropriation of said first appropriator bears to the combined appropriation of said appropriators; and shall next serve the next appropriator in priority with a like quantity of water for his proportional time, and so on, until all appropriators in said group or system are served; then the distribution of water shall be repeated in the same manner throughout the irrigation season; that in case two or more appropriators in a group or system have the same priority, then said water master shall distribute said water as between such appropriators to the one whose ditch or lateral taps the stream or ditch nearest its source or head first, and the next lower down, next and so on.

XVIII.

That in all cases where any person, firm or corporation has a right under this decree to supply and deliver water to others and charge for the same or may hereafter acquire such right, it is the duty of such person, firm or corporation to supply water to any and all persons applying for water who can use water along the line of the works belonging to such person, firm or corporation, or who can be reasonably supplied with water from said works under reasonable and uniform contracts and for reasonable and uniform charges up to the limit of the capacity of said works, so long as said person so taking water complies or is ready and able to comply with the terms of such contract. Such contract may provide for any reasonable and uniform method of pro rata distribution of water, and such person, firm or corporation may make such reasonable and uniform rules and regulations as may be necessary to facilitate such distribution. In case said contract does not provide for such distribution of water, then such water shall be supplied to the water users in the order of and according to the date of priority of use upon the land or at the place upon which such water is to be used and subject to rotation as in this decree generally provided; provided that no contract shall be made to deliver water to lands or places not theretofore supplied, to such an extent as to deprive any land or place of water which had been previously supplied; and provided further that no contract shall be made to deliver water for irrigation or power unless the land or place where said water is to be used be entitled to such use under a right granted by this decree, by a permit of the State Engineer or by a water right certificate. All contracts for the use of water giving any preference other than as herein stated are against the public policy and laws of the State of Oregon and void.

XIX.

That S. M. Bailey, H. D. Dunham, Carey W. Foster, J. H. Gray, Jessie Gray, O. C. Gray, E. W. Nelson, W. F. King, D. Koopman, Homer Norton, C. L. Reams, Marion B. Mayfield, Annie M. Mayfield, Arthur Minkler, Marion Morgan, Geo. E. Storkman have filed statements and proofs of claim herein, based upon permits of the State Engineer of Oregon. All persons claiming and using any of the water of said stream and its tributaries under and by virtue of a permit issued by said State Engineer shall have a date of priority in accordance with such permit and the extent of the appropriation shall be such amount or volume of water as shall have been put to a beneficial use at the expiration of the time as limited by such permit, ^{or extension of such time,} and a water right certificate shall be granted upon the taking of final proof thereon as provided by law. That Application 174, Permit #52 of said State Engineer held by J. S. Watkins, E. T. Slayton and T. H. Lafollette and Application #430, ^{Enlargement} Permit #24 held by Oliver Powell and Application #43, Permit #35 held by Frank S. Hoffman, have been filed herein and a certificate of water right will be granted according to law.

XX.

That T. H. Lafollette, C. M. Lister and E. T. Slayton each made application and severally filed affidavits asking that their date of priority be changed from that set forth in their respective statements and proofs of claim to an earlier date, but such application was made after the opening of said statements and proofs to inspection and said applications be and they are hereby denied.

XXI.

That T. H. La Follette, E. T. Slayton, J. W. Elliott and M. R. Biggs by agreement have been heretofore and now are during the dry season of each year taking water for stock through the Snoderly ditch to the respective places where such water can be diverted to their respective places and such agreement is hereby continued in force.

XXII.

That Peter Magers, Raymond Calavan, D. A. Sears and Harry Lanus on or about the 22nd day of July, 1912, made application to intervene in these

proceedings and filed their statements and proofs of claim. - That said Superintendent made an investigation and notified all claimants to the waters of said creek who would be affected in any way by the allowance of said claims. That G. H. Russell and the City of Prineville appeared and it was agreed between Peter Magers and D. A. Sears and G. H. Russell that certain ditches should be constructed and that the water in Marks Creek should be divided equally between said Sears and said Magers on the one part, and said Russell on the other part, until the water flowing in said creek does not exceed one second foot, and that when the flow of water in said creek is one foot or less then all the water shall be divided equally between said Sears and said Magers, and it was agreed between D. A. Sears, Peter Magers, Raymond Calavan and said city of Prineville that should said municipal corporation desire to use the water of Marks Creek for domestic and municipal purposes that the rights of said intervenors should be subsequent to said City of Prineville, and that subject to such rights, said claims were filed and are duly tabulated herein. That Richard A. Bland petitioned to intervene and submitted his statement and proof of Claim to the waters of Lytle Creek. That all parties who would be affected by the allowance of said claims were duly notified and R. H. Shriver appeared and objected to the filing of said claim, and it appearing that the rights of said Shriver were initiated by a permit of the State Engineer, #397, Application #848, dated the 14th day of August, 1910, and it appearing that the rights of said Shriver would be seriously affected and the right to intervene being investigated by said Superintendent of Water Division No. 2, said intervention was allowed, subject to all rights prior to 1911 and the tabulation of rights herein are so made in accordance with this finding.

XXIII.

In all cases in this decree wherein the right to use water out of more than one stream for the same land is confirmed, the amount of water herein determined for said right may be used out of either or both of said creeks so long as the amount of water taken does not exceed the volume named in this decree, and each creek may be used to supplement the other in furnishing said amount of water.

XXIV.

In all cases in this decree wherein the right to store water out of any stream the waters of which are herein determined and said right of storage shall be for the purpose of supplementing the right of irrigation or mining from the stream and of increasing the length of irrigation or mining season, and for the lands described under the person's name having said right. Said right of storage is limited to such an amount of water as is sufficient to supplement said right determined for said land.

XXV.

That in all cases where water is stored by any claimant said water shall be taken at any season of the year for said storage according to the dates of relative priority, and in case the owner of any reservoir desires to use the bed of any of the streams for the purpose of carrying such stored water from the reservoir to the consumer thereof, said owner of such reservoir shall install such headgates and measuring devices as the Superintendent of the division or the Water Master of the district in which the water is situated and used shall order. Said stored water may be used at any time during the year that the owner thereof may desire. Whenever said owner of such reservoir desires to use such stored water, he shall notify the water master of the district in which the stored water is to be used, giving the date when it is proposed to discharge water from such reservoir, its volume, and the names of all persons and ditches entitled to its use. Said water master shall then determine the percentage of loss by seepage, evaporation or other causes, between the place of discharge from the reservoir into the stream and the place of diversion from the stream, and shall close or so adjust the headgates of all ditches from the stream as will enable those having such right to secure the volume discharged from the reservoir less the determined loss. That in all cases where reservoirs are built so as to include within their boundaries the bed of any stream, the

waters of which are herein adjudicated and determined, the owner, manager or lessee of such reservoir shall install in the stream, above and below said reservoir, such measuring devices as the superintendent of the division or the water master of the district in which said reservoir is situated may order. The plans for the construction of said measuring devices shall be approved by the State Engineer. The said water master shall measure all water of such stream running into said reservoir and shall discharge from said reservoir sufficient water (not exceeding the volume of water running into said reservoir) to supply such prior rights as may be entitled to use said water; such discharge of water shall only be necessary during the time or season in which such prior rights are entitled to use the same. The water master shall keep a true and just account of the time spent by him in the discharge of his duties as defined in this finding, and shall file the same with the county court of Crook County, sitting for the transaction of county business. Said county court shall present a bill of one-half the expenses so incurred to the reservoir owner, manager or lessee, and if such owner, manager, or lessee shall neglect for thirty days after the presentation of such bill of costs to pay the same, the said costs shall be made a charge upon said reservoir, and shall be collected as delinquent taxes until the complete payment of such bill of costs has been made; and the rights of appropriation herein confirmed confer no rights to the diversion and use of waters which have been lawfully impounded in reservoirs and other storage works which have been, or may be hereafter, constructed in accordance with law, when the same are discharged into the natural channel of said stream, or any tributary thereof, in a lawful manner by those having a lawful right to do so; but the said rights of appropriation herein confirmed are limited and confined to the waters flowing naturally in the natural channel of said stream and its tributaries.

XXVI.

That the rights of appropriation hereby confirmed are appurtenant to the lands herein described, for irrigation purposes, and the rights of use of the waters of said stream, and its tributaries, by virtue of such rights of appropriation, are limited and confined to the irrigation of the lands herein described to the extent of said lands as herein set forth; and the priorities herein confirmed confer no right of use of the waters of said stream, and its tributaries, on the lands other than those specific tracts to which such rights of appropriation are herein set forth as appurtenant, and each and every person shall be and hereby is prohibited, restrained and enjoined from diverting and using water from said stream on such other lands without lawful permit from the State Engineer.

XXVII.

That the order of the rights of the respective appropriators of the waters of said stream and its tributaries, and in which order they are entitled to divert and use the said water shall be and is according to the date of the relative priority of the right as herein set forth and determined, and the first in order of time according to the date of relative priority shall be and is the first in order of right; and so on, down to the date of the latest priority; and those having prior rights are entitled to divert and use the waters of said stream, and its tributaries, when necessary for beneficial use in connection with the irrigation of their respective lands, or other useful and beneficial purpose for which they are decreed a right of use, at all times, and against those having subsequent rights without let or hindrance; and whenever the water is not required by the appropriator having a prior right to its use for the purposes for which said water was appropriated, he must and shall permit it to flow down in the natural channel of the stream as it was wont to flow in its natural course, without hindrance or diversion thereof, and those having subsequent rights are entitled to the use of such water and to divert the same to the extent of their rights of appropriation, according to the order of their priority rights; and at all times, the waters diverted shall be beneficially, economically and reasonably used without waste, by those having a right to do so by reason of the priority of their rights, and no rights of appropriation are hereby confirmed to divert a greater quantity of water into the head of the ditch, or ditches, of the appropriator having a valid right to divert the water than such appropriator can beneficially use for the purposes to which the water is

to be put, and in no event shall the quantity diverted exceed the quantity herein as the quantity to which such appropriator is entitled, as the same is necessary for the proper and beneficial irrigation of his lands and has been actually put to beneficial use.

XXVIII.

That the name and address of each appropriator of water from said Crooked River, arranged alphabetically, together with the date of relative priority of each such appropriation, the maximum flow of such appropriation in cubic feet per second of time, in case no rotation be arranged and provided in each case that the total quantity of water ^{for irrigation} is limited to four(4) acre feet per acre during each year, the number of acres to which such appropriation is applied, and to which such water is appurtenant, the use or uses for which such water was appropriated, and is now applied and to which such use is limited, the name of the ditch or ditches through which such appropriation is diverted, the name of the stream or streams from which such appropriation is diverted, and a description of the legal subdivision in which such irrigated land is situated, with the number of acres in each such legal subdivision, and to which land such water right is appurtenant, arranged in tabulated form and set opposite the name and postoffice address of each such appropriator, are as follows, to-wit:

These listed certificates as noted on the photocopy from the County Clerk are correct, EXCEPT No. 622, 666, 675, 681 & 682 which contain this limitation, also Correction Certificates No. 1295, 30862 & 30863, which also contain the limitation.

This limitation pertaining to the period July 1 to September 15th pertains to the contest of Wallace Post, et. al. vs. David Stewart and J. W. Carlson, see Findings No. 11, at page 307 of Crooked River Decree, and does not refer to the actual irrigation season as set forth in the findings as Feb. 1st until December 1st. of each year.

This certified document purportedly corrects the listed certificates to confirm with the irrigation season in the general findings, however as there is no record in the Record of Water Right Certificates to confirm it, these certificates can only be corrected upon request of the owners of the lands, payment of the recording fee, and the issuance by the State Engineer of a correction certificate for each.
