SUPPLEMENTAL FINDINGS OF FACT AND ORDER OF DETERMINATION.

Now on this 19th day of November 1913, the above entitled matter coming on before the State Water Board of Cregon, at a regular meeting of said Board, commenced and held on said day, in the City of Salem, Oregon, John H. Lewis, President; James T. Chinnock and Geo. T. Cochran, Superintendents, being present; and it appearing to said Board that findings of fact and an order of determination have been entered in the above entitled proceeding on the 22nd day of Jamuary, 1913, and it further appearing that petitions to intervene in accordance with Section 6656, Lord's Oregon Laws, have been filed subsequent to January 22, 1913, by claimants who received no notice of the pendency of said proceedings, or who had no actual knowledge of the same, also a petition asking the Board to consider an amended statement and proof of claim; and the Board having carefully considered such petitions, together with all maps, plats, claims and statements filed in connection therewith, and being now fully advised in the premises, makes and orders to be entered of record in its office the following

FINDINGS OF FACT:

I.

That a statement and proof of claim for water right was filed at the time of the original hearings for Charles Altschul, by C. E. S. Wood, his agent, but water right was denied because the claim was indefinite and incomplete, the decision of the Board inthis matter being set forth in Paragraph XV of the findings of fact and order of determination heretofore entered on the 22nd day of January, 1913, as follows:

"That a statement and proof of claim for water right was filed by Charles Altschul by C. E. S. Wood, his agent, but that said claim is too indefinite to ascertain what right said Charles Altschul has. That said claim is for riparian rights for lands granted by the United States for the purpose of building a military road; that said company has never used any water but has leased land to tenants who have used water on the land rented by them. That such use of water has been claimed by said tenants and tabulated so far as claimed. That by reason of said nonusage under claim of riparian rights and of such usage under claim of appropriation, said Charles Altschul has lost am forfeited any and all rights by riparian ownership in. of. or to the waters of said stream."

that subsequent to the entry of said findings, the Oregon and Western Colonization Company, successors in interest to Charles Altschul, filed with the State Water Board, a petition to submit an amended statement and proof of claim, setting forth the specific areas which had been irrigated by said claimant, and it appearing that all lands described in said claim have been actually irrigated and the Board having carefully considered the matter, and being fully advised in the premises, it is ordered that such petition be and the same is hereby granted, and Paragraph XV of the findings of fact heretofore entered by this Board, on the 22nd day of January, 1913, is modified, and the said Oregon and Western Colonization Company shall be and are hereby entitled to/certain water nights specifically described in the order of determination herein, provided that said Company shall pay its proportionate share of the expense of notifying each water user who has appeared in the proceeding.

II.

Inst retitions to intervene in the above entitled proceedings have been filed in accordance with Section 6056 Lord's Cregon Laws, by George and Henry Koch,

J. R. Knox, and the Prineville Land & Livestock Company. That each of said retitions was accompanied by a statement and proof of claim containing allmatters required of claimants who had been duly served with notice of said proceedings; a statement that the intervenor had no actual knowledge or notice of the rendency of said proceedings; and fees as required by Section 6641 Lord's Oregon Laws. It therefore appearing to the State Water Board that all requirements of the statute have been complied with, and the granting of water rights as prayed for by petitioners would apparently work no injury to existing rights, it is hereby ordered and adjudged that such petitions be and the same are hereby granted, provided that each retitioner pay his proportionate share of the expense of notifying each water user who has appeared in the proceeding.

III.

That the hereinbefore mentioned Prineville Land & Livestock Company filed with their retition to intervene, a statement by Mr. George H. Brewster, to be considered in connection with their claim; in which statement they acknowledge that the maps of the State Engineer correctly show those lands belonging to the Company which "are under a ditch and from which a crop is raised" but that the balance of the lamis described in their statement and proof of claim are all irrigated "by natural flooding and are used for pacture." From this statement it appeared to the Board that the Prineville Land & Livestock Company had not secured a right to irrigate such lands by appropriation, since no diversion or other works were constructed for the irrigation thereof, and that the flooding of these lands by natural overflow without any act on the part of the claimants did not vest in them a water right which could be recognized in these findings. The rights of the aforesaid Prineville Land & Livestock

Company are therefore hereby limited to those lands described in their statement and proof of claim which are shown on the maps of the State Engineer, and are set forth fully in the order of determination herein.

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact, the State Water Board now makes the following

## ORDER OF DETERMINATION.

That the hereinafter named claimants are each and all entitled to divert and use water to the extent set forth in the following tabulated statement, subject to all the conditions, regulations and limitations contained in the findings of fact and order of determination heretofore entered by this Board on the 22nd day of January, 1913:
