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From the initiation of the legal proceedings as above entitled to the time of the organization of Deschutes County, all legal proceedings were conducted in the Circuit Court of Oregon for Crook County.

After the organization of Deschutes County such legal proceedings were in the Circuit Court of Oregon for Deschutes County. All claims for the use of the waters of Tumalo Creek are for, or in connection with, lands now in Deschutes County. Tumalo Creek and its tributaries from the point of origin thereof to the confluence with the Deschutes River, are entirely within Deschutes County.

In all decrees or orders of the Court prior hereto it has been determined that certain rights to the use of waters of Tumalo Creek have been perfected and vested. Certain other claims to the use of waters of said stream are recognized as incheate.

On April 24, 1913, John H. Lewis, as State Engineer, and President of the Board of Control, together with James T. Chinnock, Superintendent of Water Division No. 1, and George T. Cochran, Superintendent of Water Division No. 2, made an order, under the seal of the Board of Control; extending the time for perfection of the incheate rights to October 1, 1915.

By decree of the Circuit Court of Oregon for Crook County, entered under date of March 9, 1914, the Court approved and confirmed the order of the Board of Control.

No further action was taken in this proceedings until November 17, 1949. At that time the Deschutes County Municipal Improvement District filed in the office of the County Clerk of Deschutes County, an application for the extension of time for perfecting the incheate rights to June 30, 1950.

The application of Deschutes County Municipal Improvement District was at once presented to the Circuit Court for said County and State and an order was made on November 17, 1949, granting the application as presented.

After June 30, 1950, the State Engineer of Oregon made his examination and investigation as to the perfection of the incheste water rights previously determined. On May 15, 1953, he made his Supplemental Findings of Fact and Order of Determination. This apparently was filled in the office of the County Clerk of Deschutes County on May 18, 1953.

On May 20, 1953, the Circuit Court of Oregon for Deschutes County, by order, set

August 3, 1953, as a date by which exceptions might be filed with the County Clerk of Deschutes

County as to the Supplemental Findings of Fact and Order of Determination, made by the State Engineer

of Oregon. This was continued from time to time. Finally on November 9, 1955, the Circuit Court

of Oregon for Deschutes County made an order setting time for the filing of exceptions as

January 23, 1956, and directed that hearings be held on exceptions, if any, commencing thereafter.

The State Engineer of Oregon gave notice, by registered mail, on May 26, 1953, to those claiming inchoate rights to the use of waters of Tumalo Creek to file their written exceptions by August 3, 1953, and at that time the Court would set a date for hearing upon such exceptions.

Only one exception was filed by August 3, 1953, or by January 23, 1956, the date set by the Court for filing sucy exceptions. The exception is that of L. L. McDaniel. It is directed to the failure of the State Engineer to allow his claim to water for the irrigation of land in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter and the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, all in Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 11 EMM. This is shown in Finding No. 14, at pages 8 and 9 of the Supplemental Findings of Fact and Order of Determination of the State Engineer.

The claim of L. L. McDaniel is made for water for irrigation of land within each subdivision of the Northeast Quarter of Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 11 EWM. He takes exception to the disallowance of any water right for the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said S section, and to the allowance of but 4.7 acres of water right for the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said section. No exception is taken by Mr. McDaniel to the allowances made for the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast and the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said section.

It will be noted in the decree of Judge W. L. Bradshaw, in this matter, under date of May 5, 1911, at page 15 of such decree, an inchoate water right was allowed for the Northeast Quarter of Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 11 EWM and for the Northeast Quarter of Section 3, in Township 17 South, Range 11 EWM, all under the name of Charles J. Mock, in the amount of 225 acres. There was no designation made as to what part of this inchoate water right was allowed for land in either section or any subdivision thereof.

Hearing was held upon the exceptions of L. L. McDariel, as above mentioned, on February 9, 1956. At that time, and in a session of the Court, the claimant presented evidence in his own behalf.

By the time the hearings were completed the Court requested an examination of the written transcript of the testimony submitted by Mr. McDaniel. The testimony was transcribed and filed with the County Clerk on November 18, 1957. The Court has had access thereto from that date.

From the evidence presented in behalf of claimant I find that as early as between 1922 and 1925, inclusive, there was cleared, cultivated, seeded and irrigated an acreage in each 40 acre subdivision in excess of that claimed by L. L. McDaniel. This is shown upon the map of the State Engineer as being in cultivation but not as being irrigated. I find that, at least, such acreage has been irrigated in other years prior to June 30, 1950. I find no evidence of abandonment of such irrigation at any time by the claimant, Mr. McDaniel, or by his predecessors in interest.

Based upon the testimony presented to the Court I conclude that in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 11 EWH the claimant and his predecessors in interest had cleared, propared for cultivation, had seeded and placed under irrigation 24.4 acres of land prior to June 30. 1950.

I further conclude that in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 11 EWM, the claimant or his predecessors in interest cleared, prepared for cultivation, seeded to crops and irrigated a total of 20 acres prior to June 30, 1950.

BASED UPON THE FOREGOING FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS,

IT IS DECREED that a water right is allowed for the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter for 24.4 acres and for the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter for 20 acres and that the tabulation show such allowances.

The Court affirms and approves the order of the State Engineer of Oregon as shown in his Supplemental Findings of Facts and Order of Determination, and including his tabulations, except as to the claim of said L. L. McDaniel.

HASED UPON the Supplemental Findings of Fact and Order of Retermination of the State Engineer of Oregon, with the modification thereof as above set forth, the following is a Tabulation of the water rights which are before the Court in this matter, with all essential details.
