Now at this time this cause came on for decree upon the findings and order of determination of the Board of Control as modified by Circuit Court of Union County, Oregon, and as modified and approved by the Supreme Court on appeal in accordance with the Mandate of said Supreme Court hereig set out as follows:

" BE IT REMEMBERED, that at a regular term of the Supreme Court of the State of Oregon, begun and held at the court room in the city of Salem, on the first Monday the 5th day of October, 1914.

WHEREUPON on this Tuesday the 10th day of November, 1914, the same being the seventeenth judicial day of said term, there were present:

when the following proceedings were had:

In the Matter of the Determination

of

the Relative Rights to the Waters of North Powder River and its tributaries, a Tributary of Powder River, in Union and Baker Counties, Oregon. DEPARTMENT TWO APPEAL FROM UNION. This cause having on the 29th day of June, 1914, been duly tried, argued and submitted to the court upon and concerning all the questions arising upon the transcript, redord and evidence, and then reserved for further consideration. And the court having duly considered all the said questions, as well as the suggestions made by counsel in their argument and briefs finds that there is partial error as alleged. It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court that the decree of the Court below in this cause rendered and entered be and the same is modified as set forth in the opinion of the court filed herein.

And it is further ordered that neither party recover costs in this court or in the court below.

And it is further ordered that this cause be remanded to the court below from which this appeal was taken, with directions to enter a decree in accordance herewith and to modify the decree of the court below in this cause rendered and entered as set forth and determined in the opinion of the court rendered herein, and when so modified said decree of the court below shall be affirmed and stand as the decree of this court in this cause."

The Board of Control appearing by James T. Chinnock, and Geo. T. Cochran, of the Board; water users, C. E. Davis, et als, appearing by Crawford & Eakin of counsel; water users James H. Hutchinson et als, appearing by C. H. Finn of counsel; the North Powder Mercantile & Milling Co., J. D. McPhee, James Dalton and P. L. Smith, appearing by C. E. Cochran of counsel, and the claimants, S. L. Baer, et als., appearing by Claude McCulloch of counsel; and the court being now fully advised in the premises, and in pursuance of the said Mandate of our said Supreme Court herein filed and entered in this court,

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed, that the modified findings and order of derermination of the said Board of Control filed in this court on June 18th, 1913, are here now modified in the following particulars, to-wit:

1. That in so far as said findings and modified determination of the said Board of Control attempts to limit and confine the waters diverted and used to the lands of the respective parties therein described and upon which said waters have been heretofore used, and prohibits their use upon any other lands, the said findings and Order of Determination should be and the same is here now set aside and held for naught.

2/ That in so far as said findings and modified Order and Determination fixes and determines the rights of the contestees, S. L. Baer, et als, and limits said contestees to five hundred and twenty-five miner's inches of water with priority as of 1907, the same should be and is here now set aside, and the said contestees are here now awarded One Hundred miner's inches of the waters of said

North Powder River with priority as of 1868, the same to be diverted through the Mansfield Ditches and returned to Little Muddy Creek immediately below the lands of A. J. and Lucinda Hartung; and said contestees are further awarded six hundred miner's inches, or fifteen second feet of the waters of the North Powder River with priority as of 1907 to be diverted through said Mansfield Ditches.

3. That in so far as said findings and modified Order and Determination of said Board of Control attempts to limit the rights of said claimants and water users to divert and use the waters of said stream for irrigation purposes to commence April 15th, and end September 1st, of each year, the same should be and is here now set aside and held for naught; and the said claimants and water users are hereby decreed to be entitled to divert and use for irrigation purposes, according to their respective priorities, one miner's inch of water per acre from the 1st day of March to the 1st day of July, and one half inch per acre from the 1st of July to the 1st of October of each year.

4. That in so far as said findings and modified Order and Determination of said Board of Control, finds and awards to the North Powder Mercantile & Milling Company, one thousand miner's of the waters of the North Powder River for power purposes in the operation of its flouring mill at North Powder, Oregon, with priority as of 1870, during the months and seasons of each year, the same is here now set aside and held for naught; and it is here now found, ordered, adjudged and decreed, that said North Powder Mercantile & Milling Company have no rights to either divert or use any of the waters of the North Powder River for power or other purposes during the months of July or August of each and every year, and that the claimants and water users here in on said stream above said Milling plant have acquired by adverse user for more than ten years prior to the commencement of this proceeding the right to divert and use for irrigation purposes upon their respective lands all of the waters of the said North Powder River and its tributaries during the said months of July and August of each and every year.

5. That in so far as said findings and modified Order and Determination of said Board of Control finds and awards to J. D. McPhee, James Dalton, and P. L. Smith four hundred miner's inches of the waters of said stream for irrigation purposes during the months of July and August of each year with priority as of 1870 by purchase from the North Powder Mercantile & Milling Company, the same is here now set aside and held for naught, and it is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither said J. D. McPhee, James Dalton or P. L. Smith or either of them, have, hold, possess or own or hold any right whatever by purchase from the North Powder Mercantile & Milling Company to any of the waters of said stream for irrigation or other pur-

poses during the months of July and August of each year.

That said findings and modified Order and Determination of the said Board of Control as herein above modified is here now in all things approved and confirmed and is here now made the findings, and Order of Determination of the relative rights of all claimants of, in and to the waters of North Powder River and its tributaries. And for the purpose of definitely fixing and settling the amount of water to which each of said water users are entitled with the date of priority, including the ditch through which the same is diverted and the lands upon which the same have been used, the tabulated statement made by the said Board of Control, and filed and submitted to the court as part of their Order of Determination, and as modified by this court, and the said Supreme Court is here now adopted and approved and is made a part of this decree as follows.

It is further Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed, That the rights claimed by S. W. Holmes for the irrigation of his land through the North Powder Milling and Merchantile Company's Mill Race, depends upon the use of the waste waters flowing in said Mill Race, after use thereof by the North Powder Milling and Merchantile Company, in accordance with their right set forth in this Decree, and that said claimant S. W. Holmes, is limited as to such right to the use of such waste waters, and the right decreed said claimant confers no right of use or diversion of the waters of North Powder River except as the same are diverted into said Mill Race and may come down to his place of use; and the use of said waste waters is subject to the prior rights of use and method of use and diversion thereof of said Mill Company.

That none of the claimants hereinbefore named shall be entitled to divert a quantity of water in excess of the quantity herein decreed to such claimants nor any quantity in excess of that actually required by them for the beneficial irrigation of their said lands. Said claimants may divert such quantities as the same is set forth in the tabulated statement herein, from the first of March until the first of July of each year, and after the first of July of each year, the quantity of water which each of seid claimants shall be entitled to divert shall not exceed the rate of one-half inch per acre, or one second foot to each eighty acres of the lands actually irrigated. The total quantity which any claimant shall be entitled to divert and use during an irrigation season shall not exceed in the aggregate in each case, two and onehalf acre feet per acre actually irrigated, from the first of March until the first of October of each year. The quantity of water to which each claimant is entitled is to be measured as the head of the ditch through which the water is diverted.

That the right of use for stock and domestic purposes hereby confirmed entitles the owner of such right to divert and use such quantity of water as is reasonably necessary for his household and stock use.

That the order of the rights of the respective appropriators of the waters of said stream and its tributaries, and in which order they are entitled to divert and use said water, shall be and is according to the dates of **relative** priorities of the rights as herein set forth.

That after the first of July of each year, those appropriators of small amounts of water, not to exceed one second foot, shall be required, whenever practicable, to rotate in the use of their water.

That at the time of taking the testimony in this proceeding and at the time the original Findings and Order of Determination were made herein by the Board of Control, one L. S. Kelsey had initiated the right of appropriation as of the year 1905, of the waters of North Powder River, which appropriation was at that time uncompleted and which the Board of Control, in its Order of Determination, declared the said Kelsey to be entitled to complete for the irrigation of 720 acres of land hereinafter described, through the Ellis Ditch, and the Sunnyside extention thereof; that at such time as the Board of Control shall take proof as to the completion of said appropriation and the extent thereof, and shall certify up to this court such proof, then, at that time, the right of said L. S. Kelsey or his successors in interest, to the quantity of water actually applied by him or them to a beneficial use upon said 720 acres of land, situated in the W1 of Sec. 10; NW1 of Sec. 15; NW1 of Sec. 14; and in Sec. 11; Tp. 6 S.R. 39 E.W .M., shall be a vested right to the quantity of water so applied to a beneficial use, not to exceed one miner's inch to the acre up to July first of each year and one-half miner's inch to the acre after such date.
