DETERMINATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY IN WASCO COUNTY DUE TO SEVERE, CONTINUING DROUGHT CONDITIONS

Pursuant to ORS 401.055, I find that a severe, continuing drought exists in Wasco County. Preliminary damage estimates to agriculture and local economies are unknown at this time.

The Board of Commissioners for Wasco County has declared a "State of Drought Emergency" and has requested assistance from appropriate state and/or federal agencies.

IT IS ORDERED AND DIRECTED:

- All appropriate agencies of the State of Oregon are authorized to use state personnel and equipment as necessary to assess, alleviate and/or mitigate damage from the emergency.
- 2. The Department of Agriculture is directed to coordinate assistance in seeking federal resources available to effect agricultural recovery.
- 3. The Water Resources Department is directed to coordinate and provide assistance and regulation it determines necessary in accordance with ORS 536.750.
- 4. The Oregon Emergency Management Division of the Executive Department is directed to coordinate and assist with assessment and mitigation activities as needed to address conditions resulting from this drought.
