
Gentlemen:

Recently you sent a notice to Norman Gerking, Route 1 Box 70, The Dalles, Oregon, that according to the terms of permit number 47276, the water should have been applied to the proposed use on or before October 1, 1985 and a blank form C should have been forwarded to you. Mr. Norman Gerking was killed in an accident January 28, 1983. It is for that reason that you did not receive the notice. The completion of the application of the water to the beneficial use was completed the 20th of October, 1983. We are enclosing a form C signed by Peggy A. Gerking, widow of Norman Gerking, showing such completion. This form was obtained from the Watermaster at The Dalles. We are also enclosing the check of Peggy Gerking to you in the amount of \$10.00, which is the fee as we understand it.

You will notice that they have readdressed the rural areas of Wasco County and the address of Peggy A. Gerking is now 5277 Eight Mile Road, The Dalles, Oregon 97058. It is no longer Route 1 Box 70.

Peggy Gerking is of the belief that the application and the permit had been in the name of her husband, Norman Gerking, though she is not sure whether it was in both their names or not. In any event, the water right should be in the name of Peggy A. Gerking at this time, she being the surviving widow of Norman Gerking. If this letter is not sufficient notice, would you please send whatever form or requirement you have to show that the water right is in the name of Peggy A. Gerking by virtue of her husband's accidental death in 1983.
