A portion of the James T. Cooper DLC No. 44, Township 23 South, Range 7 West, W.M., Douglas County, Oregon, said portion being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the centerline of a 60 foot wide road easement, from which point the Southwest corner of the above said DLC No. 44 bears South 4118.08 feet and East 833.91 feet; thence along the above said center line along the arc of a spiral curve to the left (the long chord of which bears North 29° 06' 30" West) 221.44 feet to the Easterly right of way line of Oregon State Highway No. 136; thence along said Easterly right of way line North 80° 42' 00" East 10.00 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod, and North 49° 22' 44" West 43.75 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod; thence leaving said Easterly right of way line and running along the Westerly line of that property described in Volume 318, Page 243 in the Deed Records of Douglas County, Oregon, as follows: North 27° 35' 05" East 152.63 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod; North 15° 49' 00" West 162.67 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod and North 6° 47' 12" West 924.05 feet to the centerline of the Umpqua River; thence downstream along said centerline South 72° 41' 30" East 575.85 feet; thence South 14° 49' 06" West 1306.29 feet to the place of beginning.

Also the following described property: Beginning at the most Southerly corner of the above parcel; thence along the Northeastery right of way line of State Highway No. 136 North 49° 27' 35" West 118.33 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod opposite Engineer's station 358+00; thence continuing along said Northeastery right of way line along the arc of a spiral curve to the left (the long chord of which bears North 32° 07' 11" West 63.71 feet) 63.71 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod; thence leaving said Northeastery right of way line North 61° 27' 14" East 204.16 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod on the Easterly line of the above parcel; thence along said Easterly line South 15° 49' 00" East 127.62 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod and South 27° 34' 16" West 162.63 feet to the point of beginning.

A 20.00 foot wide exclusive waterline easement to benefit Parcel 2 of Instrument No. 92-06005, the centerline of which is more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point along the Easterly line of Parcel 1 of Instrument No. 92-06005, records of Douglas County, Oregon, from which the above said most Southerly corner of Parcel 1 bears South 6° 41' 55" East 193 feet more or less, South 15° 49' 00" East 162.62 feet and South 27° 34' 16" West 162.63 feet; thence leaving said Easterly line of Parcel 1 West 172 feet more or less to an existing well; thence continuing along said centerline 10.00 feet and there terminating. The easement and use of the well and pump shall expire four (4) years from the recording of Warranty Deed recorded January 31, 1997 in Book 1453, Page 125, Recorder's No. 97-01902, records of Douglas County, Oregon.
