ORDER

On April 22, 1963 Mr. George H. White submitted a sworn statement that he is the legal owner of a certain water right and the real property to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same to be canceled.

The water right in question is for the appropriation of not to exceed 2.67 cubic feet per second of water from a spring branch, tributary of Walla Walla River, with a date of priority of July 16, 1909, for domestic use and irrigation of the following lands:

- 26.5 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
- 26.5 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
- 40.0 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
- 40.0 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
- 40.0 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
- 40.0 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13,
Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M.,

and is evidenced by the certificate recorded at Volume 2, page 957, State Record of Water Rights Certificates.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the State Engineer that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the State Engineer shall enter an order canceling the water right".

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the water right, evidenced by the certificate recorded at Volume 2, page 957, State Record of Water Rights, is canceled.
