ORDER

On December 19, 1960, Frank D. Overholser filed an affidavit that he claims a right to the use of 12.3 cubic feet per second of the waters of the Coast Fork Willamette River for the operation of a sawmill in the NEX YEX SEX, Section 26, Township 19 South, Range 3 West, W. M., with a date of priority of either 1878 or 1879; that he also claims a right to the use of 12.7 cubic feet per second from said stream for the operation of said mill, with a date of priority of October 8, 1947, said right being evidenced by certificate recorded at page 17370, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates; that he has abandoned said water right and requests that annual statement of water power claim No. 848 and certificate of water right recorded at page 17370, Volume 14, be cancelled.

ORS 543.730, subsection (2), provides that whenever a claimant has voluntarily authorized, in writing, the cancelation of his claim or the water right in connection therewith, the State Engineer shall cancel the claim on the records of his office, and the water right certificate theretofore issued in connection therewith, and send a certified copy of his order canceling the water right certificate to the county clerk and said county clerk shall stamp or write across the face of the recorded water right certificate which evidenced the water right canceled, the words "Canceled by Order of the State Engineer dated _______".

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that annual statement of water power claim No. 848 and certificate of water right recorded at page 17370, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be and the same are hereby canceled.
