On December 1, 1944, Deschutes County, Oregon, filed an amended application for the approval of a change in place of use of water within the boundaries of the Deschutes County Municipal Improvement District.

Deschutes County, through forclosure of tax liens, has heretofore acquired title to lands with certain water rights appurtenant thereto located within the boundaries of the Deschutes County Municipal Improvement District in Deschutes County, Oregon, described as follows:
