OAR Chapter 137, Division 004, describes the process for reconsideration of an order in other than contested case.

Findings of Fact

1. On December 6, 2005, the Department issued Certificate 81753 to confirm an additional point of appropriation authorized by an order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer Application T-6833.
2. Certificate 81753 was issued in error and duplicates Certificate 79540.
3. The Department's issuance of the certificate was as an order in other than contested case.
4. The period in which the Department may, on its own initiative, reconsider the final order has not yet closed.


Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR Chapter 137, Division 004, the Department may reconsider a final order it has issued.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

Water Right Certificate 81753 is withdrawn.
