On September 21, 1983, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Neil M. Thuresson for approval of a change in place of use of water from Cow Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.5.0 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 20184, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of R.C. and C.F. Head, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.013 cubic foot per second from Cow Creek, for irrigation of 1.0 acre in NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 33, Township 31 South, Range 4 West, WM, with a date of priority of July 28, 1950.

Water for the said right is diverted from points located within the E 1/2 SW 1/4 of Section 28, and NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 33, Township 31 South, Range 4 West, WM.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the right therefrom to a certain 1.0 acre in NE1/4 NW1/4, Section 33, Township 31 South, Range 4 West, WM.

Gary L. Ball, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1985.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 20184, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
