Authority

OAR Chapter 690, Division 086, establishes the process and criteria for approving water management and conservation plans required under the conditions of permits, permit extensions and other orders of the Department.

Findings of Fact

- 1. The City of Union submitted a draft Water Management and Conservation Plan to the Department on May 19, 2009. The statutory fees for the Department's review of the plan were received on December 28, 2009. The plan is required by the final order approving an extension of time for Permit G-11206.
- 2. The Department published notice of receipt of the plan on January 5, 2010, as required under OAR Chapter 690, Division 086. No comments were received.
- 3. The Department provided written comments on the draft plan to the City on March 16, 2010, and, in response, the City submitted a revised plan on June 4, 2010.
- 4. The Department reviewed the revised plan and finds that the plan is generally consistent with the relevant requirements under OAR Chapter 690, Division 086.

Conclusion of Law

The Water Management and Conservation Plan submitted by the City of Union is consistent with the criteria in OAR Chapter 690, Division 086.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The City of Union Water Management and Conservation Plan is approved and shall remain in effect until June 10, 2020, unless this approval is rescinded pursuant to OAR 690-086-0920.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 2. The City of Union shall submit an updated plan meeting the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 086 (effective November 1, 2002) within 10 years and no later than June 10, 2020.
- 3. The City of Union shall submit a progress report containing the information required under OAR 690-086-0120(4) by June 10, 2015.
