ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND
AN ADDITIONAL POINTS OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.211, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, PERMIT AMENDMENT T-7655 submitted by

CITY OF WOODBURN
270 MONTGOMERY STREET
WOODBURN, OREGON 97071.

The first permit to be modified is Permit G-10931 with a date of priority of JULY 12, 1988. The permit allows the use of WELL 10, in the PUDDING RIVER BASIN, for MUNICIPAL USE. The amount of water to which this permit is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.23 cubic feet per second, if available at the original well; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 8, T 5 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 1200 FEET NORTH AND 1720 FEET WEST FROM THE E $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER OF SECTION 8, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The second permit to be modified is Permit G-11921 with a date of priority of SEPTEMBER 30, 1993. The permit allows the use of DONNER WELL, in the MILL CREEK BASIN, for MUNICIPAL USE. The amount of water to which this permit is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3.12 cubic feet per second, if available at the original well; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 7, T 5 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 1200 FEET SOUTH AND 1980 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 7, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The third permit to be modified is Permit G-11922 with a date of priority of SEPTEMBER 30, 1993. The permit allows the use of NAZARENE WELL, in the MILL CREEK BASIN, for MUNICIPAL USE. The amount of water to which this permit is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 4.61 cubic feet per second, if available at the original well; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 12, T 5 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 2000 FEET SOUTH AND 540 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 12, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The fourth permit to be modified is Permit G-12029 with a date of priority of JULY 8, 1993. The permit allows the use of ASTOR WAY WELL, in the MILL CREEK BASIN, for MUNICIPAL USE. The amount of water to which this permit is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.34 cubic feet per second, if available at the original well; SW¼ NW¼, SECTION 7, T 5 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 1840 FEET SOUTH AND 920 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 7, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

OLD SP RAILROAD WELL #5 - NE¼ NW¼, SECTION 18, T 5 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 800 FEET SOUTH AND 2460 FEET EAST OF THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 18.

SHOP WELL #1 - NE¼ NW¼, SECTION 18, T 5 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 1100 FEET SOUTH AND 2500 FEET EAST OF THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 18.

SHOP WELL #2 - NE¼ NW¼, SECTION 18, T 5 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 1000 FEET SOUTH AND 2400 FEET EAST OF THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 18.

LIBRARY WELL - NE¼ NW¼, SECTION 18, T 5 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 390 FEET SOUTH AND 2100 FEET EAST OF THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 18.

SETTLEMIER WELL #4 - SE¼ SW¼, SECTION 7, T 5 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 780 FEET NORTH AND 1420 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF HALL DLC 51.

SENIOR ESTATES WELL # 1 - SW¼ NW¼, SECTION 7, T 5 S, R 1 W, W.M.; NORTH 44 DEGREES 23 MINUTES EAST 1889.8 FEET FROM SW CORNER OF HALL DLC 51.

KING WAY WELL - Lot 1 (SE¼ SE¼), SECTION 1, T 5 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 11.75 FEET NORTH AND 2380 FEET EAST FROM THE W CORNER OF BLOCK 54, WOODBURN SENIOR ESTATES NO. 5.

LEGION PARK WELL - NE¼ SW¼, SECTION 8, T 5 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 2250 FEET NORTH AND 1590 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 8.

ASTOR WAY WELL #11 - SW¼ NW¼, SECTION 7, T 5 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 1840 FEET SOUTH AND 920 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 7.

DONNER WELL #9 - NE¼ NW¼, SECTION 7, T 5 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 1200 FEET SOUTH AND 1980 FEET EAST OF THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 7.


NAZARENE WELL #7 - SW¼ NW¼, SECTION 12, T 5 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 2000 FEET SOUTH AND 540 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 12.

THESE CHANGES TO EXISTING WATER PERMITS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (wells), together with the quantity diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original points of appropriation.
2. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.
3. All other terms and conditions of the permit remain the same.

Permits G-10931, G-11921, G-11922, and G-12029, all in the name of CITY OF WOODBURN are amended as described herein.
