### **Findings of Fact**

- 1. On March 14, 2003, the Hudson Bay District Improvement Co., Inc. filed an application for an Allocation and Use of Conserved Water under Certificate 67205.
- 2. The conservation project proposed piping approximately 1 mile of open irrigation ditch. The project was expected to yield approximately 1/2 miner's inch per acre of conserved water.
- 3. On May 16, 2003, Hudson Bay District Improvement Co., Inc. requested the application be withdrawn until the HB 3111 process was complete.
- 4. The Department returned the original application to Mr. Zerba of Hudson Bay District Improvement Company.
- 5. There were no fees associated with the application.

#### NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

## Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-23 is withdrawn and is of no further force or effect.
