ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND ADDITIONAL POINTS OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7656 submitted by

CITY OF WOODBURN 270 MONTGOMERY STREET WOODBURN, OREGON 97071.

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 36537, was perfected under Permit G-2593 with a date of priority of JANUARY 24, 1964 FOR 1.0 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND AND MARCH 30, 1964 FOR 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND. The right allows the use of SENIOR ESTATES WELL NO. 1, in the MILL CREEK BASIN, for MUNICIPAL USE. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.11 cubic feet per second, if available at the original well; SW¼ NW¼, AS PROJECTED WITHIN HALL DLC 51, SECTION 7, T 5 S, R 1 W, W.M.; NORTH 44 DEGREES 23 MINUTES EAST 1889.8 FEET FROM THE SW CORNER OF HALL DLC 51, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 36538, was perfected under Permit G-2893 with a date of priority of MAY 3, 1965. The right allows the use of A WELL, in the PUDDING RIVER BASIN, for MUNICIPAL USE. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.67 cubic feet per second, if available at the original well; Lot 1 (SE½ SE½), SECTION 1, T 5 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 11.75 FEET NORTH AND 2380 FEET EAST FROM THE W CORNER OF BLOCK 54, WOODBURN SENIOR ESTATES NO. 5, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The third right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 56379, was perfected under Permit G-6354 with a date of priority of DECEMBER 26, 1974. The right allows the use of LEGION PARK WELL, in the MILL CREEK BASIN, for MUNICIPAL USE. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.67 cubic feet per second, if available at the original well; NE½ SW¼, AS PROJECTED WITHIN J. COOLEY DLC 50, SECTION 8, T 5 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 2250 FEET NORTH AND 1590 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 8, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

THESE CHANGES TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 1998.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (wells), together with the quantity diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original points of appropriation.
- 3. When required by the Department the water user shall install in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.

Certificates 36537, 36538, and 56379 are cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.
