Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On June 18, 2018, Francis Roy and Coralee Groce filed an application to change the place of use under Certificates 77326 and 77733. The Department assigned the application number T-12953.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on June 21, 2018, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On September 6, 2018, the agent for the applicants revised the application and map to better describe the place of use and proposed "TO" lands.
- 4. The Department has determined that the water rights subject to transfer are layered with water right permit S-54068 for primary irrigation in the name of Juniper Flat District Improvement Company. The applicant has stated that they do not intend to prove up the portion of Permit S-54068 on either of these associated "FROM" and "TO" lands described below in Finding of Fact No. 5 and No. 6.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 5. On September 6, 2018, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-12953 to the applicants. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of October 6, 2018, for the applicants to respond. The applicants requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicants are authorized to pursue the transfer (or amended the application or did not respond by the deadline).
- 6. On November 28, 2018, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-12953**Error! Reference source not found.** and sent a copy to the applicants. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published in the Department's weekly notice on December 4, 2018 pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

11. The lands proposed for transfer are located within the Juniper Flat District Improvement Company. Timothy Morelli, Chairman of the Board of Directors for the company, submitted a completed consent form concurring with the proposed water right transfer application.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

- 12. Water has been used within the five-year period prior to submittal of the transfer application according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 13. Diversion structures, ditch and district delivery system sufficient to use the full amounts of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-12953.
- 14. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 15. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 16. All other application requirements are met.

Conclusions of Law

The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-12953 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-12953 is approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 77326 and 77733 and any related decree.
- 3. Water right Certificates 77326 and 77733 are modified. The Department will issue superseding certificates describing the rights when it is determined that it is necessary for record keeping.
- 4. The former place of use of the transferred rights shall no longer receive water under the rights.
- 5. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2020**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the change and full beneficial use of the water.
