ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7232 submitted by

HAYWORTH FARMS, INC. P.O. BOX 264 HARRISBURG, OREGON 97446.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 28103, was perfected under Permit G-579 with a date of priority of MAY 31, 1957. The right allows the use of BASIL ROBINSON IRRIGATION WELL, in the CAMOUS CREEK (WILLAMETTE RIVER AND LAKE CREEK) BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 18.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.19 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW¼ SE¼, AS PROJECTED WITHIN MCCULLY DLC 43, SECTION 15, T 15 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 2½ CHAINS NORTH AND 30 CHAINS EAST OF THE SW CORNER OF DLC 43, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

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The authorized place of use is as follows:

NE¼ SE¼ 1.2 ACRES NW¼ SE¼ 13.2 ACRES SW¼ SE¼ 3.5 ACRES SE¼ SE¼ 0.1 ACRE

ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN MCCULLY DLC 43
SECTION 15

TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the place of use to:

NE¼ NW¼ 1.9 ACRES NW¼ NW¼ 2.2 ACRES SW¼ NW¼ 9.1 ACRES SE¼ NW¼ 4.8 ACRES SECTION 1

TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The applicant proposes to change the point of appropriation to:

WELL 1 - NW½ NW½, SECTION 1, T 16 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1010 FEET SOUTH AND 1170 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 1.

WELL 2 - SE¼ NE¼, SECTION 2, T 16 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1690 FEET SOUTH AND 260 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 2.

THESE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 2000.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.
- 3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

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- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
- 5. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this water right.

Certificate 28103 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
