The FIRST right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK County as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 75204. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 325. The date of priority is 1868. The right allows the use of MILL CREEK, a tributary of the OCHOCO CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 7.1 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second, if

The SECOND right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK County as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 75205. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 420-1. The date of priority is 1868. The right allows the use of MILL CREEK, a tributary of the OCHOCO CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 26.1 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.32 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion:

STANTON DITCH - SE% SE%, SECTION 10, T 14 S, R 17 E, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The THIRD right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK County as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 76365. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1868. The right allows the use of MILL CREEK, a tributary of the CROOKED RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 21.2 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.26 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: STANTON DITCH, or

its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

The FOURTH right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK County as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 76366. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1868. The right allows the use of MILL CREEK, a tributary of the CROOKED RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 0.9 ACRE. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: STANTON DITCH, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

THESE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. These changes are temporary. These changes shall be effective upon issuance of this order.
- The former place of use shall not be irrigated as part of this water right during the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006 and 2007 irrigation seasons.
- 3. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2007 irrigation season.
- 4. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right.
- 5. The use of the remaining water rights described by Certificates 75204 and 76365 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 75204 and 76365.
- 6. **PRIOR** to diverting of water at the new points of diversion, the water user **shall** install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
