O R D E R

On February 5, 1980, Herbert H. Hendricks submitted a statement in conjunction with transfer Application No. 4355 that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at Page 1915, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of James Noland, John M. Baxter & C. W. Thomas, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.125 cubic foot per second of water from Dry Creek, with a date of priority of January 31, 1917, for irrigation of a certain 10.0 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at Page 1915, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
