ORDER

On October 28, 1980, Mildred Van Blockland and Don Spencer submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question was established by Decree of Circuit Court for Union County, entered August 8, 1925, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Grande Ronde River, tabulated in the name of Estate of Geo. Gekeler, at Page 38, Volume 8, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, and is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at Page 20230, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Estate of Geo. Gekeler, and is for the use of water from Grande Ronde River and Gekeler Slough, with a date of priority of 1869 from Gekeler Slough and 1883 from Grande Ronde River, for irrigation of 10.0 acres in the NE¼ SW¼, 4.0 acres in the SE¼ SW¼, 13.0 acres in the NW¼ SE¼ and 9.0 acres in the SW¼ SE¼, Section 9, Township 3 South, Range 38 East, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at Page 20230, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
