ORDER APPROVING  
TRANSFER 5422

On December 14, 1983, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by W.J. Cody for approval of a change in place of use of water from Gate Creek and Rock Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 8497, Volume 8, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Gate and Rock Creek Ditch Company, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second from Gate Creek and Rock Creek, for irrigation of 1.0 acre in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 19, Township 4 South, Range 12 East, WM with a date of priority of May 23, 1925.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Gate and Rock Creek Ditch, from points located 1000 feet North and 1200 feet East from the South Quarter Corner of Section 14, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 14, and 1280 feet North and 1500 feet East from the Center of Section 21, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 21, both Township 4 South, Range 11 East, WM.

The applicant herein proposes to transfer the right therefrom to a certain 1.0 acre in NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 29, Township 4 South, Range 12 East, WM.

Thomas J. Paul, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.


No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1985.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 8497, Volume 8, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding and NOT involved in prior Transfer 4107; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
