FINAL ORDER APPROVING AN

**Findings of Fact**

1. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-10761 in the name of Shane Lundgren on September 15, 2009. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 78, at Page 891. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2010.
2. On November 8, 2010, the Department received an application for extension of time for transfer of water right T-10761 from William Smith Properties, Inc. c/o Matt Smith the receiving landowner.
3. The receiving landowner has hired Cascade Pump and Irrigation to conduct a pump test on the well and install a suitable irrigation system. However, the existing shallow well experienced excessive drawdown and needed to be deepened to allow for drawdown capacity during well pumping. The well was deepened and another pump test was conducted that indicated adequate capacity to meet irrigation needs.
4. To fully complete the change, it will be necessary for the receiving landowner to purchase and install the irrigation system and irrigate the new place of use lands.
5. The receiving landowner has requested that the time for completion of beneficial use be extended to October 1, 2011.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


**Conclusions of Law**

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the receiving landowner has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-10761.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

The time for completion of beneficial use authorized by T-10761 shall be extended to October 1, 2011.
