ORDER APPROVING CHANGES IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 537.705 and ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7189 submitted by

MARVIN L. AND CHRISTINE B. RUFFING 4904 ELLIOT PRAIRIE ROAD WOODBURN, OREGON 97071.

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 23055, was perfected under Permit 20957 with a date of priority of APRIL 17, 1950. The right allows the use of an UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of BUTTE CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 10.9 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.124 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: SE¼ NE¼, SECTION 23, T 5 S, R 1 W, WM, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 27752, was perfected under Permit G-366 with a date of priority of JUNE 19, 1956. The right allows the use of a WELL, in the BUTTE CREEK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 11.1 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 10.9 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NE% NE%, as projected within CHASE DLC 46, SECTION 23, T 5 S, R 1 W, WM; 12 CHAINS SOUTH AND 23.5 CHAINS EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, DLC 46, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.
