ORDER REVERTING A POINT OF

Findings of Fact

- 1. On November 18, 1982, DONALD BIEBERSTEDT filed an application requesting to change the points of diversion under Certificates 22997 and 22998. The Department assigned the application number T-5161.
- 2. On January 26, 1983, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving T-5161, recorded at Special Order Volume 37, Page 46.
- 3. On August 3, 1989, the applicant notified the Department that the change authorized through approval of transfer application T-5161 would not be completed, and requested that the authorized point of diversion revert back to the original points of diversion.
- 4. Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6010, the point of diversion shall revert to the last authorized point of appropriation if the change is not completed.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The point of diversion for the right affected by application T-5161 is reverted to the last authorized points of diversion prior to the transfer. A superseding certificate for the right affected by the transfer shall be issued in the name of DONALD BIEBERSTEDT.
