On November 23, 1976, R.D. Hector, Regional Maintenance Engineer for the Oregon State Highway Division submitted an affidavit that the Oregon State Highway Division is the owner of a water right and the lands to which the right is appurtenant; that Oregon State Highway Division abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right evidenced by certificate issued to Miles Lee and E.A. Van Sicklin and recorded at Page 29158, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and is for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second of water from Pine Creek, with a date of priority of August 22, 1910, for the irrigation of 6.7 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, Township 8 South, Range 39 East, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right evidenced by certificate recorded at Page 29158, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
