ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6222 submitted by

SIMPSON TIMBER COMPANY  
OREGON OVERLAY DIVISION

PORTLAND, OREGON 97217

to use the waters of NORTH AND EAST WELLS in the COLUMBIA SLOUGH BASIN for the purpose of INDUSTRIAL USE.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 50729, was perfected under Permit G-5550 with a date of priority of APRIL 12, 1972. The right is limited to 0.67 cubic foot per second; being 0.56 cfs from North Well and 0.11 cfs from East Well, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The new points of appropriation are located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN  
DLC 37, SECTION 9, T 1 N, R 1 E, W.M.; NORTH WELL - 1150 FEET  
SOUTH AND 2380 FEET WEST; EAST WELL - 1390 FEET SOUTH AND 2245  
FEET WEST; BOTH FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 9.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the new place of use is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4  
SW 1/4 NE 1/4  
AS PROJECTED WITH DLC 37  
SECTION 9  
TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.


The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1990.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. The wells at the new points of appropriation shall be constructed to the well construction standards in effect as of the date of this order and must include access ports.
5. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Certificate 50729 is canceled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
