ORDER

Now at this time this matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer on application of the Goose Lake Valley Irrigation Company, which was allowed an inchoate water right by the decree of the court in the adjudication of the waters of Drews Creek, Antelope Creek, Cottonwood Creek, Thomas Creek and Cogswell Creek, and their tributaries, tributaries of Goose Lake; and

It appearing that the time as heretofore fixed for the completion of such rights has expired and that said company has not fully completed its inchoate rights, although it has made reasonable efforts to reclaim its lands within the time allowed and has used due diligence in the prosecution of the work necessary therefor; and that good cause has been shown for an extension of said time.

NOW, THEREFORE, It is hereby ORDERED that the Goose Lake Valley Irrigation Company shall have until October 1st, 1935, within which to complete its rights.
