

Permit Amendment Review Criteria

4. The change would not result in injury to other water rights.
5. The change does not enlarge the permit.
6. The change does not alter any other terms of the permit.


Conclusions of Law

The additional point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-13594 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The additional point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-13594 is approved.
2. Permit G-18744, in the name of SARBANAND ENTERPRISES, LLC, is issued to replace Permit G-18272, and incorporates the amendments approved by this order. Permit G-18272, in the name of SARBANAND ENTERPRISES LLC, is no longer of any force or effect.
3. The combined quantity of water diverted at the new additional point of appropriation (East Airport Well 2), together with that diverted at the old point of appropriation (East Airport Well), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation (East Airport Well).
4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
5. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-18744 remain the same.
