ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN USE, POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6270 submitted by

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to use the waters of WELL #62 in the COLUMBIA RIVER BASIN for the purpose of INDUSTRIAL USE (LANDFILL OPERATION).

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 52085, was perfected under Permit G-4918 with a date of priority of FEBRUARY 3, 1970. The right is limited to 0.185 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 23, T 2 N, R 26 W, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The new point of appropriation is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 5, T 2 N, R 26 E, W.M.; 2340 FEET SOUTH AND 1600 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 5.

The amount of water used under this right together with the amount used under the Columbia River supplemental right authorized by transfer 6270 shall not exceed 128 acre feet per calendar year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the new place of use is as follows:

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed before October 1, 1991,  
*Extended to 10-1-95*
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation and together with the Columbia River right being approved under this transfer shall not exceed 128 acre feet.
3. The water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. The well at the new point of appropriation shall be constructed to the well construction standards in effect as of the date of this order and must include an access port.
5. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
6. The following former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 10.5 ACRES  
NW 1/4 SW 1/4 10.0 ACRES  
SW 1/4 SW 1/4 12.1 ACRES  
SE 1/4 SW 1/4 7.6 ACRES  
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 5.4 ACRES  
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 7.3 ACRES

TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.

Certificate 52085 is canceled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
