ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN USE, PLACE OF USE,
AND POINTS OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6828 submitted by

CROOKED RIVER RANCH
P.O. BOX 1477
CROOKED RIVER RANCH, OREGON 97760.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by an order of the Water Resources Director, entered November 6, 1991, at Special Order Volume 45, Page 460, was perfected under Permit G-2280 with a date of priority of JANUARY 24, 1963. The right allows the use of WELL 2, in the CROOKED RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 86.7 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.08 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 24, T 13 S, R 12 E, WM; WELL 2 - 680 FEET SOUTH AND 780 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 24, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

This use may be regulated if analysis of data available discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be reduced.

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the use, place of use, and point of appropriation of 1.0 acre of irrigation to MAINTENANCE OF PONDS using 0.01 CFS from WELL 1 in:

The applicant proposes to change the place of use and point of appropriation of irrigation using WELL 1 to:

The proposed points of appropriation are located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 14; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 24; T 13 S, R 12 E, WM; WELL 1 - 2480 FEET NORTH AND 60 FEET WEST FROM THE S $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 14; WELL 3 - 140 FEET NORTH AND 770 FEET EAST FROM THE S $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 24.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THESE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 1998.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (wells), together with the quantity diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.

3. The quantity of water diverted for maintenance of ponds is limited to a rate of 0.01 cubic foot per second, and further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet, during the irrigation season of each year.
4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
5. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this water right.

Proper proof of completion of the change in place of use allowed by order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer 6604 has been received. A certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
