Pursuant to requests by Portland General Electric/Enron, the water right holder, in letters dated August 13 and 18, 1997, the Oregon Water Resources Department will take the following actions.


The state license expiration dates for the following hydroelectric projects are extended to August 31, 2006, to correspond with the expiration date set out in license no. 135 issued by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission for these projects:

HE 186, Timothy Lake: former expiration date 12/31/2002
HE 202, North Fork Faraday: former expiration date 12/31/2005
HE 203, Faraday Unit 6: former expiration date 12/31/2005

The Oregon Water Resource Department will process the applications for reauthorization for the Pelton and Round Butte projects, license nos. 217 and 222 prior to their expirations dates of December 31, 2010 and December 31, 2011 respectively, in order to correspond with the expiration date of December 31, 2001 as set out in license no. 2030 issued by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission for these projects.

NOW, THEREFORE the expiration dates for hydroelectric license nos. 186, 202, and 203 are extended in accordance with Section 13(1)(a) of House Bill 2119 enacted by the 69th Legislative Assembly, and the reauthorization applications for license nos. 217 and 222 will be processed prior to their expiration dates according to Section 13(1)(b) of House Bill 2119.
