ORDER

On May 14, 1979, Joseph C. & Edna E. Brooks submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question was established by Decree of Circuit Court for Jackson County, entered May 19, 1964, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of the Rogue River, tabulated in the name of James Trefren, at Page 384, Volume 13, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, and is described by the certificate recorded at Page 42923, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of James Trefren, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.081 cubic foot per second of water from Evans Creek, with a date of priority of 1902, for domestic, stock, and irrigation of 4.9 acres in Lot 9 of Pleasant Valley Farm Tracts, being SW4, SW4, SE4 SW4, Section 15, and NE4 NW4, NW4, NW4, Section 22, T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water right, described by the certificate recorded at Page 42923, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled. Dated at Salem, Oregon, this 17th day of May, 1979.
