
Findings of Fact

1. On April 9, 2018, the Department issued an order approving Transfer T-12806. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 107, Pages 1046-1053.
2. This order is issued to correct scrivener's errors in Finding of Fact #18. Corrections are shown in **bold**.
3. Finding of Fact #18 as shown in Special Order Volume 107, Pages 1046-1053: "The authorized places of use are "no longer irrigated" as defined in ORS 540.572(7). Based on the evidence contained in the letters and required notices, water was not put to beneficial use on the authorized lands shown in Finding of Facts #7 and #10, above, during the 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016 irrigation seasons."
4. Finding of Fact #18 should be corrected to read: "The authorized places of use are "no longer irrigated" as defined in ORS 540.572(7). Based on the evidence contained in the letters and required notices, water was not put to beneficial use on the authorized lands (**not marked with an asterisk**) shown in Finding of Facts #8 and #11, above, during the **2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, and 2017** irrigation seasons."

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. Finding of Fact #18 in the order approving T-12806, as recorded in Special Order Volume 107, Pages 1046-1053 is hereby corrected as shown in Finding of Fact #4, above.
2. All other provisions of Special Order Volume 107, Pages 1046-1053 remain in effect.
