Findings of Fact

1. On February 28, 2023, the Department cancelled this permit in accordance with the provisions of ORS 537.260.
2. The Permittee's Certified Water Right Examiner (CWRE) requested reconsideration of the February 28, 2023, order canceling the permit asserting that one of the permit holders of record was not notified
3. The Department has determined that the notice of cancellation was not served on all permit holders of record.

The Department on its own motion elects to reinstate the permit.


Conclusions of Law
