O R D E R  
APPROVING APPLICATION

On January 27, 1936, R. C. Dodge, of 2425 Southeast 24th Avenue, Portland, Oregon, filed an application for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from an unnamed stream, tributary of Salmon River, Clackamas County.

Under Certificate of Water Right recorded on page 7827, Vol. 8, State Record of Water Right Certificates, said applicant has a right to the use of .05 cubic foot per second of the water of an unnamed stream, tributary of Salmon River, for domestic use on the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{2}$ , Sec. 9, T. 3 S., R. 7 E., W.M., the point of diversion from said stream being located 465 feet S., 42° E. of the W $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Sec. 9, same township and range.

It is proposed to change the present point of diversion to a point upstream to be located approximately 750 feet S. and 50 feet W. from the NE corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 8, T. 3 S., R. 7 E., W. M.

Notice of publication is not required in connection with said application for the reason that the change in point of diversion is less than one-quarter mile and there are no intervening diversions between the old diversion of the applicant and the proposed new diversion.

It appearing that such change can be made without injury to existing rights,

Now, therefore, it is hereby ORDERED that said application be and the same is hereby approved.
