NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 2.5 acres in SE4 SE4, Section 35, Township 39 South, Range 8 West, W.M., be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 2.5 acres in NE4 SE4, Section 35, Township 39 South Range 8 West, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1977.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of waterright heretofore issued to Lynn R. Stone and Joyce I. Stone and recorded at Page 30548, V me 22, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right not involved in this proceeding, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of application of water to beneficial use, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Louis N. and Wilda C. Maurer confirming the extent to which water has been applied beneficially.
