The following Permittee has requested reconsideration of the September 9, 2004, order canceling their permit. The request for reconsideration was submitted within the timeline provided by the order.



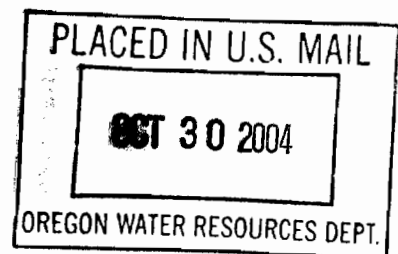
NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the permit is reinstated in accordance with the provisions of ORS 537.260
