ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2351

On March 26, 1970, Lyle K. Soner filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Hurricane Creek, pursuant to the provisions of CRS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Wallows County, Oregon, entered January 20, 1919, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Wallowa River and its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of E. P. Castor for the use of the waters of Hurricane Creek for domestic and stock use, with a date of priority of 1879, and the irrigation of, among other lands, 20.0 acres in NEX NEX, 18.5 acres in NWX NEX, with a date of priority of 1881, and 33.0 acres in SWM NEW, with a date of priority of 1892, Section 36, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W.M. The water is conveyed to these lands by means of the Robbins-Bonner Ditch from a point of diversion located S 36° 31' W 588 feet from the W% corner of Section 36, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W.M. being within the NEW SEW of Section 35. Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W.M. The diversion point of record is through the Old Settlers Slough, Castor and Page Ditches from a point of diversion located 680 feet south and 650 feet east from the NW corner of Section 36 being within the NWA NWA of Section 35, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to convey water to these lands by means of the Noonshine

Ditch from a point of diversion to be located S 76° 02' W 49 feet from the NE corner of Section 3 being within the NEW NEW of Section 3, Township 3 South, Range 44 East, W.M.

Metice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in Enterprise, Oragon, on July 3, 1970, at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in the Wallows County Chieftain, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Wallowa County, Oragon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of May 7, 14, and 21, 1970. The data set for hearing in said matice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. Walter L. Astwood, Watermaster of District No. 7, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in point of diversion of water from Hurricane Creek, to-wit:

From a point located S 36° 31' W 588 feet from the WA corner of Section 36, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W.M. being within the NEX SEA of Section 35, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W.M.

To a point to be located S 76° 02' W 49 feet from the NE corner of Section 3 being within the NEM NEM of Section 3, Township 3 South, Range 44 East, W.M.

for domestic and stock use, with a data of priority of 1879, and the irrigation of, among other lands, 20.0 acres in NEW NEW, 18.5 acres in NEW NEW, with a data of priority of 1881, and 33.0 acres in SWM NEW, with a data of priority of 1892, Section 36, Township 2 South, Range

44 East, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1971.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion and shall not exceed 1% acrefeet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1.0 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be carried out prior to the diverting of water at the new point of diversion as herein confirmed.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the wair or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

The right to the use of water from Hurricane Creek for the irrigation of 9.0 acres in NEW NEW, Section 36, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W.M. evidenced by certificate of water right recorded at page 2976, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, was canceled by an order of the State Engineer entered September 21, 1970.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heratofore issued to E. P. Castor and recorded at page 2976, Volume 4, State
Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled and upon receipt of
proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized
change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be

issued to Lyle K. Boner confirming said change in point of diversion.
