## Authority

ORS 537 establishes the process by which an application to use water may be submitted. OAR Chapter 690, Division 310 implements the statute, and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating applications to use water.

## **Finding of Fact**

- 1. Willamette Tree Wholesale filed an application for a permit to appropriate the public waters of the State of Oregon with the Water Resources Department.
- 2. The Department issued a Final Order on November 19, 2007. The Final Order identified that outstanding permit recording fees in the amount of \$300.00 must be submitted to the Department no later than 60 days from the date of the Final Order and that failure to pay the required permit recording fees within 60 days from the date of the Final Order may result in the proposed rejection of the application.
- 3. On January 27, 2010, the Department sent a letter by certified mail to the applicant, which stated that permit recording fees shall be submitted no later than March 28, 2010, and that the application would be rejected if the fees were not received by such date.
- 4. Both the Final Order and the certified letter indicated that an administrative hold may be sought by the deadline.
- 5. The applicant failed to submit permit recording fees or a request for an administrative hold by March 28, 2010.

## ORDER

It is ORDERED the above-listed application is hereby REJECTED and is of no further force or effect.

Appeal Rights

This is a Final Order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. This statement of judicial review rights does not create a right to judicial review of this order, if judicial review is otherwise precluded by law.
