On May 10, 1976, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Morrow Bros. for a change in place of use and point of diversion under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right recorded at Page 13619, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Grizzly Livestock & Land Co., describes an existing right of record for the use of water from Willow Creek for irrigation of a certain 240.91 acres with a date of priority of 1886, being:

Water for the said right is diverted from two points located (1) 350 feet North and 2650 feet East and (2) 1400 feet North and 1000 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 21, being within the (1) SW4 SE4 and (2) NW4 SW4 of Section 21, Township 12 South, Range 15 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to sever the right from a certain 0.46 acre in SE4 SE4 of Section 19; 9.33 acres in SW4 SW4, 3.85 acres in SW4 SE4, 3.1 acres in SE4 SE4 of Section 20; 1.79 acres in SW4 SW4 of Section 21; and 6.5 acres in NW4 NE4 of Section 29, Township 12 South, Range 15 East, W.M., and without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 1.7 acres in SE4 NE4, 0.86 acre in SE4 SW4, 4.88 acres in NW4 SE4 of Section 20; 11.9 acres in SW4 NW4, 3.6 acres in NW4 SW4 of Section 21; and 1.95 acres in NE4 NE4 of Section 30, Township 12 South, Range 15 East, W.M.

The applicant proposes to maintain the two points of diversion described in paragraph three, above, and to establish three additional points of diversion located (1A) 900 feet North and 2080 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 21, being within the SE½ SW½ of Section 21; (2A) 1465 feet North and 1440 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 20, being within the NW½ SE½ of Section 20; and (3) 450 feet North and 150 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 19, being within the SE½ SE½ of Section 19, all within Township 12 South, Range 15 East, W.M., for irrigation of all of the lands under the subject water right, being:

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in

the Madras Pioneer, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jefferson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of April 7, 14, and 21, 1977.

Mr. Bruce A. Estes, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in place of use and point of diversion as described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, together with the diverted at the old points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old points of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general suprevision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the changes in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Grizzly Livestock & Land Co., and recorded at Page 13619, Volume 12,

ر کام ر State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
