ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3815

On October 6, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Brooks Resources Corp. for approval of a change in place of use of water from Deschutes River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County, Oregon, entered September 30, 1958, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Deschutes River and Its Tributaries, a water right was allowed in the name of Arnold Irrigation District for the use of waters of Deschutes River for irrigation of, among other lands, a certain 20.0 acres in SW4 NW4, 21.5 acres in NW4 SW4, 31.7 acres in SE4 SW4, 25.8 acres in SW4 SE4 of Section 24; 12.9 acres in  $NE_4^1$ ,  $NE_4^1$ , 35.8 acres in  $NW_4^1$ ,  $NE_4^1$ , 5.7 acres in  $SW_4^1$ ,  $NE_4^1$ , 0.1 acre in SE<sup>1</sup>4 NE<sup>1</sup>4 of Section 25, Township 18 South, Range 12 East, W.M.; 27.5 acres in NE4 NW4, 37.5 acres in NW4 NW4, 9.0 acres in SW4 NW4 and 15.5 acres in SE4 NW4 of Section 30, Township 18 South, Range 13 East, W.M., being tabulated in the name of Harry Kerns at Volume 16, page 31, with dates of priority of February 1, 1905 and April 25, 1905, as evidenced by certificate recorded at page 29053, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates. These lands also have a supplemental right under permit No. 23256 to the use of water stored in Crane Prairie Reservoir with a date of priority of February 28, 1913. These lands are irrigated by means of the Arnold Canal.

The applicant herein proposes to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority, to a certain 1.5 acres in SE4 SE4 of Section 13 (Jerry Moseley); 2.5 acres in SW4 NW4 of Section 20 (Ward Construction Corp.), 10.0 acres in SW4 NW4 and 10.0 acres in NW4 SW4 (Stephen R. Rodgers); 5.0 acres in SE4 SW4 (Gerold Huston); 12.0 acres in SE4 SW4 (Bruce Estes); 10.0 acres in SW4 SE4 (Richard Silveus); 7.0 acres in SW4 SE4 (Michael Brown); 4.0 acres in SE4 SE4 (Harold Kelly); 1.0 acre in SE4 SE4 (Troy Clement), Section 24; 2.5 acres (Tom Bighous), 2.5 acres (Christian Weber), 5.0 acres (R. Buescher) in NE4 NE4; 5.0

acres (T. Foxworth), 5.0 acres (S.Tutt) in SE¼ NE¼, 7.0 acres (J. Yahna), 5.0 acres (G. Yahna) in NW¼ NE¼; 3.0 acres (J. Yahna), 2.0 acres (Frank Ribera), 1.5 acres (M. Gates), 1.5 acres (P. Imbs) in SW¼ NE¼, Section 25; all in Township 18 South, Range 12 East, W.M.; 10.0 acres in NW¼ NW¼ (Marvin Mix); 10.0 acres in NE¼ NW¼ (Pierce Cornelius); 5.0 acres in SW¼ NW¼ and 10.0 acres in SE¼ NW¼ (Garland Lundgren); 5.0 acres in SW¼ NW¼ (R. Schock); 5.0 acres (Thomas Dehm) and 5.0 acres (R. Walton) in NW¼ SW¼; 2.5 acres (Arthur Anderson), 2.5 acres (Alan Lewis) and 5.0 acres (Marion Wooley) in SW¼ SW¼, Section 19; 32.7 acres in NE¼ NW¼, 27.3 acres in NW¼ NW¼, 8.0 acres in SW¼ NW¼ and 12.0 acres in SE¼ NW¼, Section 30; all in Township 18 South, Range 13 East, W.M.

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Arnold Irrigation District and said District approved the proposed change in place of use of water.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1982.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Arnold Irrigation District confirming this and prior changes within the District.
