On December 2, 1983, John W. and Suzanne Woodman submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 51279, Volume 46, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of G.H. Harrell, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.011 cubic foot per second of water from North Umpqua River, with a date of priority of May 13, 1963, for irrigation of a certain 0.9 acre in NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 14, as projected within McKinney DLC 45, Township 26 South, Range 6 West, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 51279, Volume 46, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right NOT involved in this proceeding, and not modified by the order approving Transfer 5259.
