- 1. On February 14, 2011, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving the temporary changes proposed in Transfer Application T-11182. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 83, Pages 614-618.
- 2. Under the order, the water right would revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2015 irrigation season.
- 3. On January 26, 2015, the applicant requested Transfer Application T-11182 be terminated early.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. Temporary Transfer T-11182 is terminated and of no further force or effect.
- 2. The use shall revert to the places of use authorized under Certificates 80773 and 85285.
